Mot All Romance Novels Are Created Equal

What makes one romance novel croon like an Italian love song, while another puts the reader to sleep?

One zings.

Noun: An enjoyably exciting or stimulating quality

Verb: To make or move with a humming sound

One zonks.

Verb: Stupefy; cause to sleep; induce an unconscious state



Which zings? Which zonks?

"I don't give up easily." Warm against her skin, his breath sent powerful shivers of something magical through her senses. "Not when I know what I want — and I do. I always have." Pulling away, he captured her gaze with his relentless one. "I want you, *Bella Mia*. For always...forever."

Example 2:

Zinging words and phrases

WORDS/PHRASES THAT SPEAK THE LANGUAGE OF LOVE (NARRATIVE AND DIALOGUE) IN VARIOUS ROMANCE CATEGORIES:

Examples of Romantic Descriptions

in Narrative:

- Heart-stopping gaze/smile/touch
- Lingering glances/ fingertips brushing skin
- Breathless anticipation/ whispered promises
- Undeniable connection/ spark
- Soft, reverent caresses/ gentle sighs
- Magnetic pull

Examples of Romantic Phrases in Dialogue:

- "I can't stop thinking about you."
- "You feel like home to me."
- "Being with you is the best part of my day."
- "You're my favorite what-if that came true
- "Tell me you feel this, too."
- "I would cross oceans for you."
- "You're the only one I see."

The following examples illustrate the contrasting language between <u>sweet</u>, tender romance and a more <u>passionate</u> physical attraction, where romance may not be involved at all.

The Language of Sweet, Tender Romance:

(Narrative words/phrases that can evoke warmth, devotion, and emotional intimacy.)

- Gentle whispers / soft caresses / lingering touches
- Devoted gaze / eyes full of love
- Heart swelling with emotion / an overwhelming sense of belonging
- Holding the romantic partner as if they're the most precious thing in the world
- Feeling seen, understood, cherished
- Love steeped in quiet moments—watching the sunrise together, brushing a stray curl from her face, resting her head on his shoulder

(Dialogue that evokes warmth, devotion and emotional intimacy)

- "You're my safe place."
- "I love the way you make me feel—calm, whole, understood."
- "You are my greatest adventure."
- "I don't need anything else, just you."

CONTRAST: Language of Pure Sexual Attraction:

(The focus is on physical chemistry, intensity, and urgency.)

- Heat pooling in their belly / heart racing at the other's touch
- Fingers gripping tightly / breath hitching / tension crackling
- Hunger in their eyes / magnetic pull between them
- Skin flushes, charged energy buzzing in the air
- Kisses that steal breath, that demand response
- Wanting, without needing to understand the person

Dialogue (Pure sexual attraction):

- o "I can't stop thinking about the way you feel."
- "You drive me crazy! I need you...now."
- "Every time you look at me like that, I lose control."
- "Do you have any idea what you do to me?"

Sweet and tender romance taps into emotional connection, devotion, and the feeling of safety and belonging.

In contrast, pure sexual attraction focuses on <u>physical desire</u>—sometimes urgent, sometimes teasing, but <u>without the emotional</u> <u>depth of true love</u>.

Inspirational Romance

Often balances **tender longing** with **spiritual fulfillment,** showing that love isn't just about finding someone, but becoming the person you were meant to be alongside them.

The following passages illustrate the depth of **inspirational romance**—love that uplifts, strengthens, and endures. Moments like these weave faith, commitment, and quiet strength into romance, making it about more than attraction. It's about finding **home** in someone's heart.

Passage 1 – A Love That Feels Like a Divine Gift

He reached for her hand, not to hold it, but to ground himself in the reality of her. The simple truth that in all the chaos, all the heartache, she had remained his quiet miracle.

"You are the most beautiful proof that God answers prayer," he murmured, emotion thick in his voice.

Gentle but sure, her fingers curled around his. "Then keep praying," she whispered. "And know that I'll always be here."

Passage 2 - Love That Guides Them Home

He stood at the edge of the dock, eyes searching the heavens. The wind carried his silent thoughts like a prayer—one that somehow brought her to his side.

"I don't deserve you." Barely more than a murmur, his voice all but vanished beneath the quiet lap of the waves.
