Dance groups may perform **one dance per category**.

PARTICIPATION CATEGORIES:

- Small Group:** 3–7 participants
- Formation:** 8–24 participants
- Production:** 25 or more participants

AGE DIVISIONS:

- Baby:** 4–6 years
- Kids:** 7–9 years
- Children:** 10–12 years
- Juniors:** 13–15 years
- Adults:** 16–25 years
- Adults 2:** 26+ years

MUSIC DURATION & REQUIREMENTS:

- **Small Group:** 2:00–2:30
- **Formation:** 2:30–3:30
- **Production:** 3:00–4:30

If the music exceeds the allowed duration, it will be stopped.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Technique
- Synchronization
- Artistry
- Costumes and visual aesthetics
- Compliance with the selected dance style

DANCE FLOOR SIZE:

10 m x 10 m

(The dance floor dimensions are provided as a performance condition.)

REGISTRATION RULES & DEADLINES:

Preliminary registration for participation in the festival-competition must be submitted by

March 15, 2026, 24:00 via: <https://eurodances.com>

After March 15, applications may only be accepted upon approval by the event organizers.

Important:

Submitting the participant/group application form confirms your agreement with all festival-competition rules and regulations.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Registration deadline: March 15, 2026, 24:00

- **1 dance/performance:** €20 per dancer
- **2 dances/performances:** €25 per dancer
- **3 dances/performances:** €30 per dancer

A dancer may perform **a maximum of 3 dances/performances**.

Spectator ticket price: €10

If necessary, the organizers reserve the right to amend the festival-competition rules and regulations. The organizers also reserve the right to move a performance to another category if the choreography does not comply with the selected style.

Categories may be merged if fewer than three performances are registered in a category.

All decisions are made in accordance with IDF practice and are final.

AWARDS

- **1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners** earn the right to represent Lithuania at the **2026 World Dance Championship in Spain** – diplomas, trophies, medals
- In the **Baby** category, all participants are awarded 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place
