Address: Birchfield Primary School, Birchfield Ave, off Street Lane, Gildersome, Leeds LS27 7HU



The Grass pitches are located within the school grounds of Birchfield Primary School. To enter the school you can either walk or drive into the school car park (limited parking available) from Street Lane directly on to Birchfield Ave. The school is directly in front of you. On foot follow the path to the right of the school carpark (when facing the school), pass through the gates, walk forward and via right following the path down into the field to find the grass pitch, or if in the carpark exit the carpark via the gate in front of the school and follow the path to the right of the school (if facing the school). Pitch location is shown on the “pitch location” map page 2.

- Please use the car park provided on site & **optimise your parking** to enable as many cars as possible to fit on site.
- Please **DO NOT** block others without owners permission & please do not use the disabled spaces **unless you can display your disabled parking permit**.
- Please **DO NOT** obstruct the emergency access at the main entrance.
- If parking roadside, please adhere to parking laws and please respect neighbouring businesses, **DO NOT USE** their car parks or **BLOCK THEIR ENTRANCE**.
- If parking near private dwellings, please **DO NOT PARK** on grass verges or **BLOCK** our neighbour's driveways/roads.
- **DO NOT BRING DOGS ON SITE.**

GUIDANCE FOR COACHES, PLAYERS, PARENTS & GUARDIANS FOR TRAINING & MATCHPLAY

GSJFC Officers have reviewed both the latest government and FA guidance and have devised the following rules that should be followed in addition to our existing club rules, which should be adhered to along with the current government and FA guidance:

Instructions and guidance from GSJFC coaches, managers and officers should always be followed.

1. Please ensure you adhere to the code of conduct whilst attending training & matches especially around the language you use and behaviours towards others.
2. All spectators must remain & stay in the designated areas behind the "Respect Barriers," unless instructed otherwise by a GSJFC coach, manager or officer.
3. Parents & Guardians will remain responsible for any belongings including any drinks and items of clothing at all times.
4. Players & spectators should enter the designated area no earlier than their notified start time unless directed by a GSJFC coach, manager or officer.
5. Please ensure that children are dressed appropriately for the match with correct footwear and shin pads (these must cover the shin adequately) and please ensure they have outer coats etc in line with the weather.
6. Whilst on school grounds can you please adhere to the No Smoking or Vaping policy.
7. Dogs are NOT permitted anywhere in the school grounds.

We will strictly follow all these rules and as such will operate a warning and exclusion policy:

1st breach of the rules – warning given

2nd breach of the rules – asked to leave and excluded for a duration to be decided by officers, managers and coaches

We hope all players will enjoy the training sessions and matches and we look forward to welcoming you all to our Club in the safest way possible.
