## **Springbank Playing Fields**

Address: Off Springbank road, Gildersome, Leeds LS27 7DJ



The Grass pitches are located within the Springbank Playing Fields off Springbank Road. Travel either down Spring Ave or Moorland Ave which will lead you to Springbank Road. The Playing fields entrance is on Springbank Road and is accessed via walking through the barrier to the grass, walk approx. 20m straight forward on the grass, then via to the left. The football pitch is located on a highrise mound, see page 2 for location. There is no car park at this site.

- If parking roadside, please adhere to parking laws and please respect Please DO
   NOT block others without owners permission & please do not use the disabled spaces unless you can display your disabled parking permit.
- Please DO NOT obstruct the emergency access at the main entrance or to the playing fields at any time.
- If parking near private dwellings, please DO NOT PARK on grass verges or BLOCK our neighbour's driveways/roads.
- Please do not double park on the roadsides, as this causes obstruction and blocks roads.

## GUIDANCE FOR COACHES, PLAYERS, PARENTS & GUARDIANS FOR TRAINING & MATCHPLAY

- 2. All spectators must remain & stay in the designated areas behind the "Respect Barriers," unless instructed otherwise by a GSJFC coach, manager or officer.
- 3. Parents & Guardians will remain responsible for any belongings including any drinks and items of clothing at all times.
- 4. Players & spectators should enter the designated area no earlier than their notified start time unless directed by a GSJFC coach, manager or officer.=
- 5. Please ensure that children are dressed appropriately for the match with correct footwear and shin pads (these must cover the shin adequately) and please ensure they have outer coats etc in line with the weather.
- 6. Whilst on school grounds can you please adhere to the No Smoking or Vaping policy.

We will strictly follow all these rules and as such will operate a warning and exclusion policy:

1<sup>st</sup> breach of the rules – warning given

2<sup>nd</sup> breach of the rules – asked to leave and excluded for a duration to be decided by officers, managers and coaches
