GILDERSOME PRIMARY GRASS PITCH GUIDE





The Gildersome Primary School

Address: Gildersome Primary School, Town St, Gildersome, Leeds, West Yorkshire LS27 7AB



The Grass pitches are located within the school grounds of Gildersome Primary. When entering the school you can either walk or drive up the school's drive way from Town street. On foot follow the path to the right of the school building (when facing the school), pass through the gates, walk right through the playground until the end. At the end of the playground follow the path around the back of the school to the left and you will see the grass pitch on the right hand side behind the school (Shown page 2 pitch location).

- Please use the car parks provided on site & optimise your parking to enable as many cars as possible to fit on site.
- Please DO NOT block others without owners permission & please do not use the disabled spaces unless you can display your disabled parking permit.
- Please DO NOT obstruct the emergency access at the main entrance or to the playing fields at any time.
- If parking roadside, please adhere to parking laws and please respect neighbouring businesses, DO NOT USE their car parks or BLOCK THEIR ENTRANCE.
- If parking near private dwellings, please DO NOT PARK on grass verges or BLOCK our neighbour's driveways/roads.
- DO NOT BRING DOGS ON SITE.

GUIDANCE FOR COACHES, PLAYERS, PARENTS & GUARDIANS FOR TRAINING & MATCHPLAY

GSJFC Officers have reviewed both the latest government and FA guidance and have devised the following rules that should be followed in addition to our existing club rules, which should be adhered to along with the current government and FA guidance:

Instructions and guidance from GSJFC coaches, managers and officers should always be followed.

- 1. Please ensure you adhere to the code of conduct whilst attending training & matches especially around the language you use and behaviours towards others.
- 2. All spectators must remain & stay in the designated areas behind the "Respect Barriers," unless instructed otherwise by a GSJFC coach, manager or officer.
- 3. Parents & Guardians will remain responsible for any belongings including any drinks and items of clothing at all times.
- 4. Players & spectators should enter the designated area no earlier than their notified start time unless directed by a GSJFC coach, manager or officer.=
- 5. Please ensure that children are dressed appropriately for the match with correct footwear and shin pads (these must cover the shin adequately) and please ensure they have outer coats etc in line with the weather.
- 6. Whilst on school grounds can you please adhere to the No Smoking or Vaping policy.
- 7. Dogs are NOT permitted anywhere in the school grounds.
- 8. Parents/guardians take their children to the toilet. Coaches **must always consider standard safeguarding rules/guidelines** when sending a child to the toilet they must be accompanied by their responsible adult. Coaches will not be able to take children to the toilet.

We will strictly follow all these rules and as such will operate a warning and exclusion policy:

1st breach of the rules – warning given

2nd breach of the rules – asked to leave and excluded for a duration to be decided by officers, managers and coaches
