# STREET LANE GRASS PITCH GUIDE





#### **Gildersome Street Lane Pitches**

Address: 25 East View, Playing Fields, Gildersome, West Yorkshire LS27 7HS



The grass pitches are located off East View road in the playing fields opposite the row of houses. Access is from the roadside with numerous entries onto the playing field from the path that travels the full length of the field.

- Please use the car park within the grounds of Gildersome Sports Club, off Street Lane, Gildersome LS27 7HX, the entrance is on the opposite side of the road down in between two bunglows to the left of the road of the football pitches (behind the row of houses). There are two car parking locations within the grounds. There is access by foot via a snicket next to Gildersome Sports Club from the top small car park or you can return on foot back out of the entrance drive and cross the road to the football field. See the Pitch location map on the next page.
- Roadside parking is available at this site, however we do ask you not to block or make it difficult for others to move up and down this road. DO NOT DOUBLE park. This is a main Bus route.
- When parking roadside, please always adhere to parking laws and be careful when exiting and entering your vehicles.

- Please respect other neighbouring businesses and DO NOT USE their car parks or block their entrances.
- When parking near private dwellings, please DO NOT PARK on grass verges or BLOCK our neighbour's driveways/roads.
- When crossing roads, please take care, it is difficult for road users to see small children when there are parked cars, do follow the highway code and DO SUPERVISE CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES WHEN CROSSING THE ROADS

### **Toilets & Changing Rooms**



#### Toilets

The toilets are across the road in the Gildersome Sports Club. Please cross the road safely and all children MUST be supervised. There are two entrances to access the grounds of the sports club. One is down the snicket which is over the road opposite pitch 2, in between the houses. Once in the car park the club will be in front of you.

The Second access to the Sports Club grounds is located further down East View road and is opposite the far end of pitch 1. Follow the driveway in between 2 bunglows (it looks like you are heading towards farm fields), continue to follow the driveway to the left and eventually you will see Gildersome Sports Club.

If the Sports Club is open entirely you can gain access via the side door, left of the club when facing it, or via the main entrance at the front of the club. The toilets are inside to the right of the bar. If the Sports Club is closed, the toilets can still be accessed via the changing room doors found at the far end of the Sports club building (they are slightly set back-see map for details). Enter through the changing rooms (unless in use), turn left through the door at the back of the changing room and in front of you will be the shower room, go through the next door, which is left if you are facing the shower room, into the toilets.

#### **Changing rooms**

There are two changing rooms (home and away) available at Gildersome Sports Club; these can be accessed from the outside of the club to the right of the building when facing it (see map above). Or through the men's toilets via the right hand door after entering the men's toilet entrance. This leads you into the showers on the right and then two doors in front of you and to the side are the changing rooms. Please clean after use and leave the changing rooms as you found them. Please do not leave litter in these rooms.

#### **Safeguarding**

Coaches must always consider standard safeguarding rules/guidelines when sending a child to the toilet and they must be accompanied by their responsible adult. Players u18 cannot use the same changing rooms as 18 or overs to change, and Coaches will not be able to take players to the toilet or be present in changing rooms of U18s if they are changing. U18s can arrive in kits and leave in kits with no requirement to change or shower.



## GUIDANCE FOR COACHES, PLAYERS, PARENTS/GUARDIANS FOR TRAINING AND MATCHPLAY

GSJFC Officers have reviewed both the latest government and FA guidance and have devised the following rules in addition to our existing club rules, which should be adhered to along with the current government and FA guidance:

Instructions and guidance from GSJFC coaches, managers and officers should always be followed.

- 1. Please ensure you adhere to the code of conduct whilst attending training & matches especially around the language you use and behaviours towards others.
- 2. All spectators must remain & stay in the designated areas behind the "Respect Barriers," unless instructed otherwise by a GSJFC coach, manager or officer.
- 3. Parents & Guardians will remain responsible for any belongings including any drinks and items of clothing at all times.

We will strictly follow all these rules and as such will operate a warning and exclusion policy:

1<sup>st</sup> breach of the rules = warning given

2<sup>nd</sup> breach of the rules = asked to leave and excluded for a duration to be decided by officers, managers and coaches

We hope all players will enjoy the training sessions and matches and we look forward to welcoming you all to our Club in the safest way possible.
