Liability for contents

Collection and use of your personal data, types of data collected

Personal data

While using our service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that may be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Usage data

Usage data

Usage data is automatically collected when you use the service.

Usage Data may include information such as your device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and the unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When you access the Service with or through a mobile device, we may automatically collect certain information,

including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you are using, the unique ID of your mobile device, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile phone operating system, the type of mobile internet browser you are using, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends when you visit our Service or when you access the Service with or through a mobile device.

Comments and contributions

When users leave comments on the blog or other posts, their IP addresses are stored. With the newsletter we inform you about us and our offers.

If you would like to receive the newsletter, we require a valid email address from you as well as information that allows us to verify that you are the owner of the email address provided or that the owner agrees to receive the newsletter. No further data will be collected. This data is only used for sending the newsletter and will not be passed on to third parties.

When you register for the newsletter, we store your IP address and the date of registration. This storage serves solely as proof in the event that a third party misuses an email address and registers to receive the newsletter without the knowledge of the authorised person.

You can revoke your consent to the storage of the data, the email address and their use for sending the newsletter at any time. The revocation can be made via a link in the newsletters themselves, in your profile area or by sending a message to the contact options above.

Registration function

The data entered during registration is used for the purpose of using the offer. Users may be informed by e-mail about information relevant to the offer or registration, such as changes to the scope of the offer or technical circumstances. The data collected can be seen from the input mask within the scope of registration. This includes name, postal address, email address, IP address for forum, newsletter.

Tracking technologies and cookies

Type: Session cookies - Managed by: Us
