



Welcome to our event at VIRginia International Raceway. Thank you for signing up to participate in this event. With your help, this will be an educational, exciting, enjoyable and, most of all, safe event.

Drivers are financially responsible for any and all damages they make to a facility and its parts, including those that result from any on-track incident such as contact with foam barriers, guardrails, etc. You will be billed by TrackDaze for any damage you incur to the facility. The only insurance covering drivers and their vehicles at the facility is their own.

## **Important Reminders**

- 1) Forms: Evaluation forms are online. All you need for on-site tech and registration is the following:
  - a) Technical Inspection Form Completed PRIOR to the event (REQUIRED)b) Medical Information (OPTIONAL)
- 2) Check-in for participants will take place in the paddock starting at 6:00pm until 7:30pm on Thursday. Check-in for participants attending Saturday & Sunday will start at 5:30pm on FRIDAY evening. Trailer and equipment drop-off's can be done starting at 5:30pm. Tech and Event Check-in will open again at 6:30am on Friday and Saturday morning. Please contact us at <u>cat@9fest.com</u> if you have any questions.
- 3) <u>Please go to the EVENT TECH area FIRST.</u> Once you have completed your event tech you may then come to registration with ALL of your forms filled out. If you do not hand in all of your forms you will NOT be allowed on the track.
- 4) You must provide your own car numbers. You may use painters tape to create your numbers. Your car number is the number you selected when you filled out the registration form online.
- 5) CAMPING is ALLOWED for this event!
- 6) All participants must have a helmet with a minimum safety rating of SA2015.
- 7) All participants **must be present** for the <u>8:00 AM ALL HANDS MEETING</u> the mornings of the event or you may miss valuable track time!

## INSTRUCTED (Green/Blue) Group:


- Between turns 3 and 4
- Bridge Straight
- Between turns 15 and 16
- Back Straight
- Front Straight

Intermediate (Yellow) and Advanced (Black):

- Anywhere on the track.

Instructor and Licensed (Red) run group is open passing. No point-by required.

- Anywhere on the track.
