DAY 1

Into the Jungle & Chocolate Ritual

We start with a 7:00 AM pickup from your hotel or the airport in Quito, heading through the Andes into the lush Amazon. Around 11:30 AM, you'll arrive at Luz de Luna Glamping for a welcome drink and a delicious lunch at 12:30 PM.

After check-in at 2:00 PM, enjoy a hands-on cacao workshop where you'll craft your own chocolate using ancestral techniques. The rest of the afternoon is yours to relax in the sauna, Turkish bath, hydromassage, or pool. At 7:30 PM, dinner is served under the stars—your first jungle night begins.



DAY 2

Culture, Waterfalls & Nightlife

After breakfast, you'll take a canoe ride across the river to reach the Gringoyacu Indigenous Community. There, you'll connect with local traditions, learn about their lifestyle, and admire their handmade crafts—with the chance to support them directly. It's a meaningful cultural exchange in the heart of the jungle.

Back at Luz de Luna, enjoy a delicious Amazonian lunch and get ready for an afternoon visit to the peaceful Rainbow Waterfall—a perfect place to relax, take photos, and enjoy the surrounding nature.

As night falls, join a guided night walk to explore the forest after dark. With a flashlight and local guide, you'll spot frogs, insects, and experience the jungle's magical nocturnal side. End the day with a warm dinner and a restful night at the lodge.



DAY 3

Birdsong & Goodbye

Start the day with birdwatching at 6:00 AM, as the jungle awakens with the sounds of toucans, parrots, and other vibrant species. After this peaceful experience, enjoy a hearty breakfast surrounded by nature. The rest of the morning is free for you to relax, explore the trails, take a final dip in the pool, or simply soak in the last jungle moments.

At 12:30 PM, gather for your final Amazonian lunch. By 3:00 PM, your return journey to Quito begins. Sit back, relax, and reflect on your unforgettable experience as you arrive back in the city around 8:00 PM.
