How It Works

Lessons are divided in to 6 different units, 1 for each term. For each year group, there will be 6 increasingly detailed units, building upon last years' learning and development.

Term 6	FAMILY/FRIE NDS	Emotions, Family, Friends

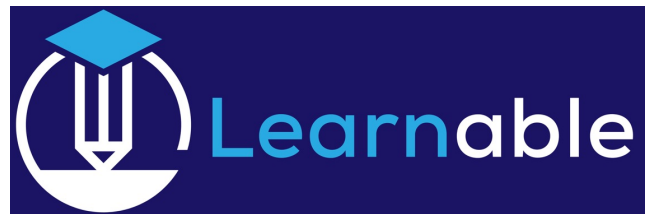
How It Works

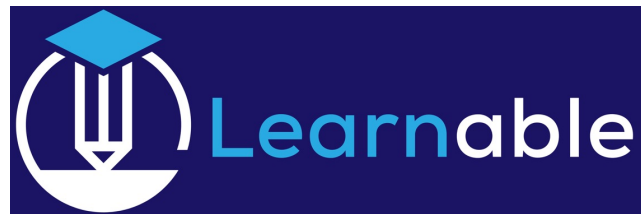

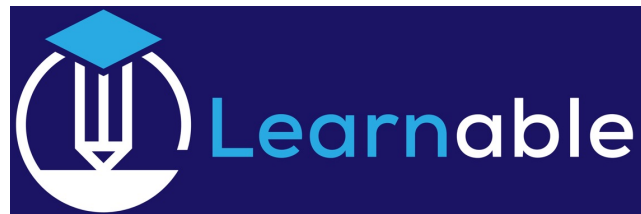
