They will learn music production and recording, instrument skills, music history, music theory and bandleading/choir skills.





What Will Be Achieved

Within a year, the children will have a solid foundation in music and be able to create their own songs, using a variety of instruments as well as being able to lead others whilst playing music.





How It Works

Lessons are divided in to 6 different units, 1 for each term.

For each year group, there will be 6 increasingly detailed units, building upon last years' learning and development.
