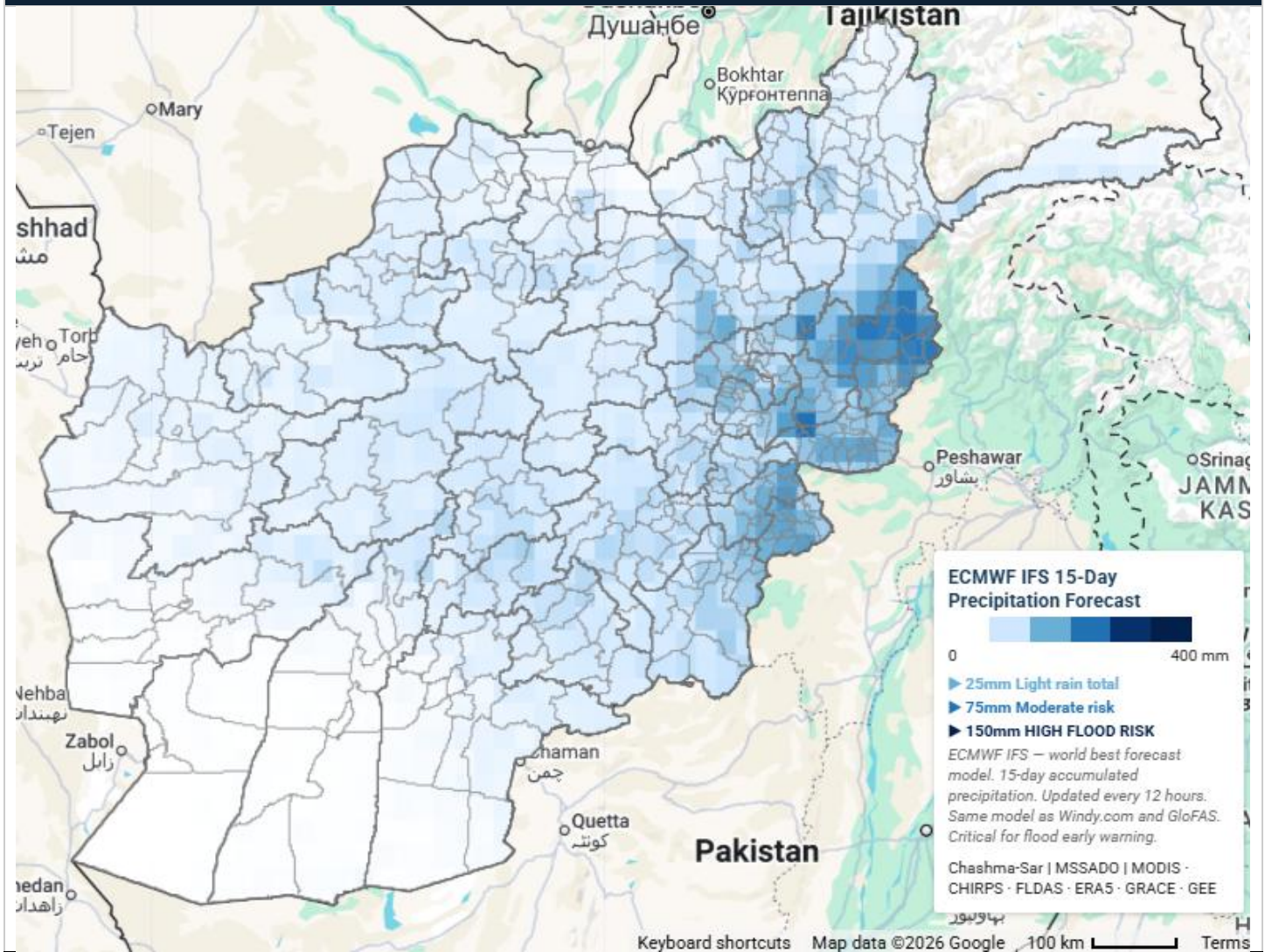

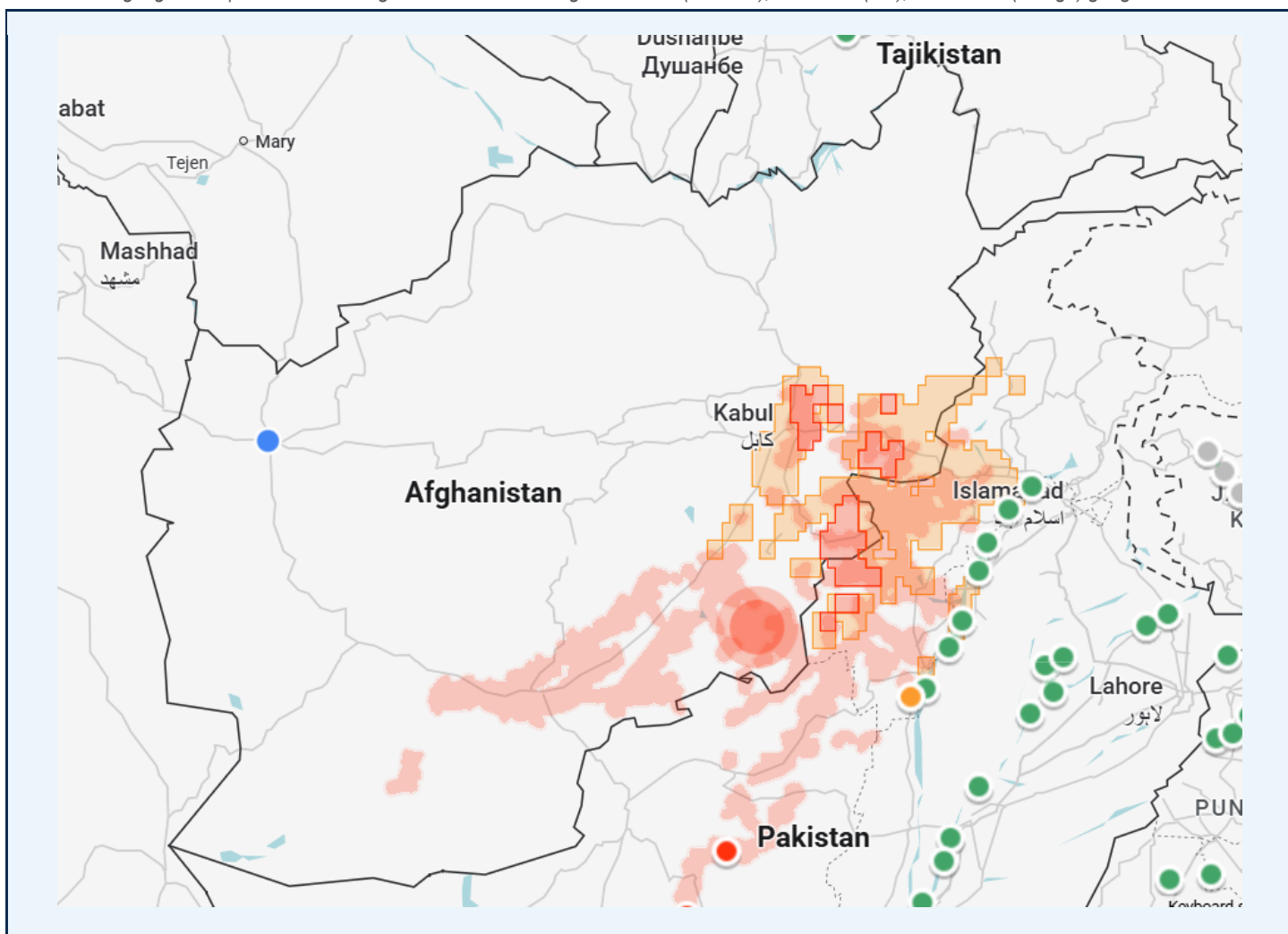

Kunar — Asadabad	EXTREME	Highest forecast in country: 202mm. Access limited
Nuristan — all	EXTREME	197mm. 3 children killed landslide. Remote access only
Khost — Khost (Matun)	DANGER	152mm. Urban flooding. Khost-Paktia road closed
Nangarhar — Jalalabad	DANGER	Kunar River confluence. 166mm province mean
Laghman — Mehtarlam	ALERT	143mm. Alishang, Alingar districts elevated

Priority Humanitarian Action — Next 48-72 Hours

Sector	Priority Areas	Recommended Action (verified data)
Flood Emergency	Kunar (202mm), Nuristan (197mm), Khost (192mm), Nangarhar (166mm), Laghman (160mm)	Pre-position supplies NOW. 51 deaths confirmed (ANDMA/Amu TV Apr 2). 2,700+ families displaced. Days 1-7 ECMWF most reliable. Evacuate river-adjacent communities. Coordinate with ANDMA.
Search & Rescue	Kandahar (EXTREME gauge), Helmand — Sangin, Lashkargah, Baghlan (thousands of homes lost)	EXTREME discharge — Arghandab River (Google Flood Hub). IOM confirms thousands of homes destroyed in Baghlan (The National, Apr 2). Deploy SAR teams by helicopter — roads impassable in multiple districts.
Roads / Access	Salang Pass, Herat-Kandahar, Khost-Paktia, Herat-Islam Qala	93km roads destroyed (ANDMA, AP Mar 30). Salang: 4m snow — 9 northern provinces cut from Kabul. Power off in 12 provinces. Pre-position supplies east of Salang. Alternative routing via Bamyan.
WASH	Kunar, Nuristan, Baghlan, Logar, Kabul (Surobi)	24 water sources + 53 supply networks damaged (ANDMA/KabulNow Mar 30). 244+ livestock killed — carcass contamination risk in waterways. Test water quality in all flood zones. Assess hand pump status urgently.
Food / Livelihoods	Badghis (VHI=45), Faryab (VHI=48), Herat (VHI=52), Samangan	2,901 jeribs (~580 ha) agricultural land destroyed (ANDMA/KabulNow). FAO warned flash flood risk Mar 30-Apr 5 across central/eastern/SE Afghanistan. May wheat harvest at risk in west. Activate EFSA now.
