- ➡ Who is liable for fixing damage to a rental property?
- ➡ What can I do if I believe the Disputes Tribunal did not make the right decision?
- ➡ What should I do if someone is harassing me?
- ➡ How much will a Family Dispute Resolution (FDR) cost me?
- ➡ Who can apply for New Zealand residence in the Skilled Migrant Category?
- ➡ The car I bought from a dealer is faulty. What can I do?
- ⇒ How do I find out who owns a particular property?
- ➡ Lam having financial problems can I withdraw some of my KiwiSaver funds early?

Can't find it? Call us on freephone 0800 367 222 (0800 FOR CAB), or chat using the chat symbol **O** at the bottom right of our homepage. The Chat is not a bot, it is a real person, a volunteer. Introducing - Harnish Campbell

MP for Ilam

Bishopdale has played an important part in my life. I remember my parents taking me to the elephant slide in the Bishopdale Park when I was young, a tradition that I have continued with my two young children.

I was born and raised in the Ilam Electorate, going to primary and secondary school here before following my passion for science at the University of Otago, where I obtained a PhD in cancer and viruses. Writing about coronaviruses long before they were in the public vocabulary.

After completing my degree, I was recruited as a cancer research scientist at the Children's Medical Research Institute in Sydney and more recently as the Deputy Head of Research at Multiple Sclerosis, Australia. Giving me insights into the needs of those facing chronic diseases and disabilities.

Following a successful

international career in the medical research space, my wife Carol and I made the choice to move back to the Ilam Electorate to raise our two young daughters and get involved in the community. (Continued on page 6)

Together we run an online florist business, and Campbell's Organic Orchard, which we partner with our family. Both businesses are in the Ilam electorate, and I strongly support local businesses as I believe they help create a strong, prosperous community.

The Ilam electorate is undoubtedly the best electorate in the country, it stretches from Hagley Park all the way to nearly West Melton, from Riccarton to Bishopdale and beyond. I am here to help if you have any issues whether that is to assist you in dealing with government departments, advocate for you where possible and represent your views in parliament.


