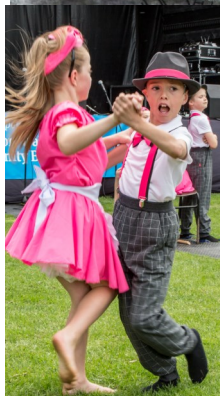
Celebrate Bishopdale 2024 is set to be a fun-filled, exciting day with something for everyone. You don't want to miss out.

What do the WINZ traffic lights mean?

The traffic light system applies to benefits with work-related and / or social obligations (hence, not superannuation). Anyone on a WINZ benefit can now see what colour code they are on by logging into MyMSD.

A green light means the person is meeting their obligations.

Orange means they are not, and WINZ has not accepted their reason for this. The person must make an appointment with WINZ. At this appointment, they will be set an activity that they must complete within 5 working days.

Red means that they did not complete the activity within 5 days. WINZ has reduced or stopped their benefit.
