## Making sure you get the assistance you need

Kia ora koutou. My name is Pete Boock and I am a qualified social worker volunteering at the Bishopdale Community Trust. My work includes being the Community Navigator and facilitating the POND group, where parents, guardians and supporters of



neurodiverse children meet every Tuesday 10am to 11.30am during term time.

The meetings are where attendees can celebrate their successes or discuss challenges. They can exchange ideas, strategies and feel empowered to honour themselves and their children in a strength-based, nonjudgmental environment.

The role of Community Navigator is to assist parents/ guardians to access the various community organisations that can support them in their challenges of parenting a neurodiverse child. This can include support for the child, other sibling, parents, guardians and the whanau. I am not there to take over the role of the various social agencies that exist in Christchurch, but to listen and navigate the family to the appropriate organisation.

Agencies that can be accessed for support include, but are in no way limited to: Work & Income, Tenancy Tribunal, Age Concern, Enabling Good Lives, CCS Disability Action, LifeLinks, Manawanui, Florence Nightingale, Salvation Army, ACC Sensitive Claims, Champion Centre, Conductive, Cerebral Palsy Society, Blind and Low Vision NZ, Deaf Association, Kainga Ora, and Oranga Tamariki.

We are also looking at hosting speakers during the year to discuss topics such as the new criteria for funding.

money that has benefited many worthy organisations and individuals in the Canterbury community.

Some of the major benefactors from Bookarama over the years have included:

- Brain Tree Trust \$25,000 (gym equipment for their new facility)
- Dementia Canterbury \$ 15,000 (vehicle)
- Queens Park School \$16,000 (van post earthquake)
- Youth Hub Trust \$14,000 (fit out of kitchen in new facility)
- Youth Programmes \$100,000 (for individuals and groups)
- Burnside Primary School \$30,000 (supply of Duffy Books twice a year for 6 years)

## HELP! Heating costs have skyrocketed!



Problems paying your power bill? Help is on hand.

If you are a homeowner with a low income, you might qualify for the Warmer Kiwi Homes subsidy, which can help you insulate your home and install efficient heating systems. Plus, some banks now offer home loan top-ups and subsidies to assist you in making your home more energy efficient.

What's more, the Winter Energy Payment is back in May! This top-up aims to keep homes warm and dry in winter. If you receive a Work and Income benefit (including NZ Superannuation or Veteran's Pension) you will automatically receive a Winter Energy Payment from 1 May to 1 October, along with your regular weekly or fortnightly payment. Single recipients get \$20.46 per week, while couples or those with dependents receive \$31.82 weekly. People living overseas or receiving an equivalent government-funded overseas pension are ineligible, as are those receiving Residential Care or Support Subsidies.

Recipients travelling overseas can continue to receive the Winter Energy Payment for up to 28 days. For longer absences, inform the Ministry of Social Development directly or log into MyMSD, select 'Something has changed', and then 'I'm going overseas'.


