## Breathing new life into the old Mitre 10 building

Many Bishopdale locals will remember the old Mitre 10 building as a long-standing feature of our community. After sitting vacant for some time, this familiar site is now being carefully redeveloped by Fitz Consulting, in conjunction with Toru Hoa Properties, to create a modern, vibrant hub that serves both the community and local businesses.

The building is undergoing a complete transformation inside and out. The exterior is being reclad, with new windows and doors installed to bring in natural light and create a more welcoming street presence. Upstairs, new office space will support small businesses and professional services, while the ground floor will host a mix of tenants designed to meet everyday community needs.

We're excited to share that Snap Fitness will be opening a new gym, helping locals stay active and healthy close to home. Tend Medical Centre will also be joining the site, making healthcare more accessible right here in Bishopdale. In addition, we are carefully selecting retail and hospitality operators for our smaller 120m² units — businesses that will complement the wider mix on site and bring fresh services, energy, and convenience to the neighbourhood.

We are also open to engaging with businesses interested in the smaller tenancies and the new 180m² office space upstairs. These spaces will be available at competitive rates for a newly redeveloped building, offering an exciting opportunity for local operators and professionals who want to be part of Bishopdale's next chapter.

Our vision for this property is not simply about renovating a building – it's about revitalising a cornerstone of Bishopdale. We want this to be a place where people can access essential services, maintain their wellbeing, and feel proud of the area they live in.

At Fitz Consulting, in conjunction with Toru Hoa Properties, we see this as an investment in the future of Bishopdale. We believe this development will contribute to a stronger, more connected community, and we look forward to welcoming you into the renewed space once doors begin to open later this year.

## Let's catch up with...

#### Joanna Lee, owner of Nova Denture Clinic at 21 Bishopdale Court



#### How are you doing?

I'm very well, thank you! I'm thrilled to be part of this interview and to have the chance to introduce myself and our clinic in the bulletin.

#### Are you a native Cantabrian?

I'd like to think so! I was born in Wellington, but Christchurch has really been home for as long as I can remember. My family moved here when I was just two, and I grew up right here in the Garden City. Apart from a few years away in Dunedin for university, Christchurch has always been my place. It's where I've built my life, my friendships, and now my clinic. I truly love this city and feel lucky to call it home.

#### How did you come to work with dentures?

My mum was probably the biggest influence. She noticed early on that I was quite creative but also had a real love for science, and she encouraged me to consider dental technology as a career. It turned out to be the perfect blend of both art and science. I enjoy being hands on and creative while also working with people. That combination really drew me in, and love working with dentures and helping people smile with confidence.

#### Why did you decide to open your own business?

I spent many years working for a large denture company and learned so much along the way. Over time, I started to feel that I wanted to do things a little differently and create something of my own. Opening my own clinic felt like the right step as I enjoy working closely with people, taking the time to create quality dentures for each patient, and build something that reflects my own values.

### Why did you decide to open your denture clinic in Bishopdale Mall?

I have really fond memories of Bishopdale Mall, I used to come here with my family when I was little, so it's always been a familiar and welcoming place to me. When the opportunity came up to lease a space here, it just felt right. It's nice to be part of a spot that already has that sense of community and history for me.

#### What services does your denture clinic offer?

We offer a full range of denture services, including full and partial dentures, as well as repairs and relines. Whether someone needs a brand new set, a small adjustment, or a quick repair, we can help. My goal is to make the process as simple and comfortable as possible, so people can get back to smiling and feeling confident again.

#### Where does the name Nova come from?

Nova means newness and brightness, and I felt it was the perfect name for the clinic. My hope is that we can give people not only a new smile, but also the confidence and brightness that comes with it. For me, it's about more than just dentures, it's about helping people feel like themselves again.

#### How is the business going?

Starting out on your own is always a bit of a leap, and I'll admit it can feel a little quiet at times but the business is still new and growing. But I've already had some wonderful support from the local community, and I'm especially grateful to Andrew and Vicki from Time Dental who have been so encouraging. What keeps me positive is knowing that I've set up in a place I love, and I'm excited to meet more people as word spreads. It means a lot when locals choose to support small businesses like mine.

#### What are your opening hours?

We are open Tuesday to Friday, from 9am to 4pm. On Mondays I'm at the hospital, and the clinic is closed on weekends. I'm always happy for people to pop in for a chat if they'd like to see what we do, and I can also arrange a later evening appointment if needed — just give me a call first to organise it.
