

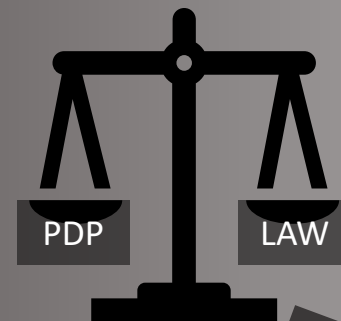
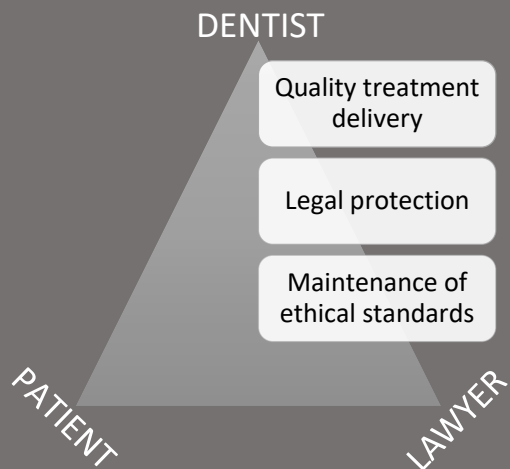
Fixing the communicative gap between BLACK & WHITE in Pediatric Dental Practice and Law

Customized validated survey questionnaire designed & circulated amongst lawyers

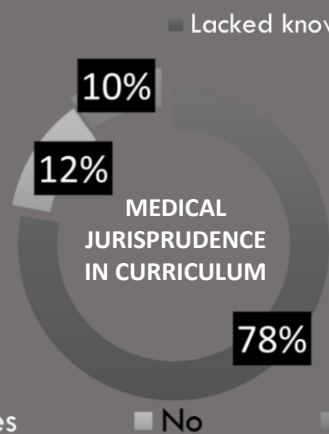
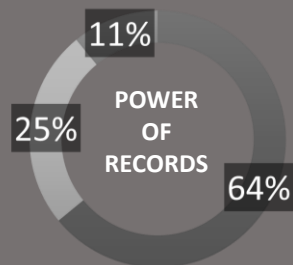
Lawyers registered under Bar Council of India with English proficiency
