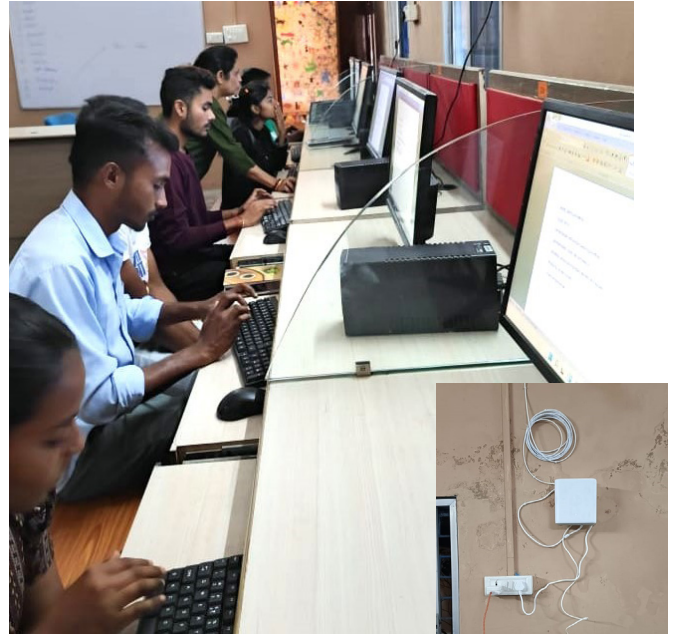
# A Govt Camp to facilitate locals
