




in the Procreate App



Create a canvas and change the DPI to 300

Go to Actions - Canvas - Crop and Resize -Settings - DPI - 300






Find these 3 brushes (or ones you like) and pin them in Recent brushes

Monoline (calligraphy), Script (Calligraphy) Soft Brush (Airbrushing). To pin slide the brush to the left and click on **pin**.

Draw your pumpkin outline!

Pumpkins come in all sorts of shapes and sizes. It doesn't matter what yours looks like! Squashed, flat, tall, round, plump... go for it! Use the Monoline brush.




Duplicate this layer!

This is important. It is what lets you do shading and highlights easily. Drag the layer to the left and **Duplicate**


Fill the pumpkin main colour

Fill on the lower of the two layers


Add the stalk and a leaf

Add a new layer *underneath* the main pumpkin later. You may need to add it above and press down on it to move it below (drag).

Add a clipping mask for shading

Add a new layer above the main pumpkin later. Click on it and choose **Clipping Mask.**

This is where you add any shading.







Add the shading and highlights

Use the Soft Brush to make the highlights and shading.

Blur the highlights and shading

Use the **Gaussian Blur** in the **Adjustments** menu to blur the colours. Drag your pen along the screen from left to right.





Add the lines and any additional highlights

Use the Monoline and Script brushes to add any final touches and lines.


Add an eye and duplicate the layer

Add a new layer then draw a circle or oval for an eye and add any light highlights. Duplicate the layer by draggin to the left and using Duplicate. Use the select icon to move the second eye into place.

Add a new layer and add a mouth!
