



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SUMMARY OF KEY PRCJECTS

WATER SUPPLY & SEWERAGE SECTOR

i) Secondary Towns and Rural Community
 Based Water Supply and Sanitation Project Sri Lanka: Consultancy Services for Design
 and Construction Supervisions - Package B

(May 2003-December 2013) Project Cost: USS 263.3 Million

Design and Construction Supervision of Water Supply & Sanitation Projects to serve secondary towns of Batticaloa, Hambantota, Malara, Muttur and Polonnaruwa, and Rural areas of Anuradhapura and Polonnaruwa District to deliver safe water to about 969,000 people and provide sanitation to 171,500 people.

ii) Kandy City Wastewater Management Project: Consultancy Services for Construction Supervision

(Dec. 2011 - Feb. 2018) Project Cost: US\$ 162 Million

The project provides consultancy services for implementing Design review and Construction Supervision of Sewerage Treatment Plant, Main Pumps Station and Pumping Main and Collection Systems, and Construction of house connection and provision of sanitary facilities for low income areas.

RURAL WATER SUPPLY SECTOR

i) Second Community Water Supply & Sanitation Project, Sri Lanka -Technical Assistance for Project Implementation Support.

(Nov. 2003 - June 2010) Project Cost: US\$ 50 Million

The World Bank assisted 2nd CWSSP was targeted to provide water supply and sanitation facilities to rural communities in approximately 1,000 Grama Niladari Divisions in North Western, Central, North and East Provincial Council (PC) areas. The project introduced a highly decentralized approach for service delivery.

(ii) Eastern Province Water Supply Development Project (Rural Water Component)

(Oct. 2010 - March 2013) Project Cost: US\$ 9.5 Million

This project was aimed at improving water supply to remote villages where there is a severe demand for drinking water. The project selected 28 such target villages suffering from water shortage, to undertake investigations and provision of pipe borne water supply to benefit 10,000 beneficiaries in the 3 districts.
