GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Current C.B.T.F. rules and regulations as of January 1st, 2026 will be in effect and strictly enforced.
2. Judges' decisions are final. Tabulated results are final 48 hours after competition ends.
3. Competition director reserves the right to divide or combine age divisions as entries warrant, but the broadest divisions to be used will be 6-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18+ Note: the minimum age to compete (individual events, duet and teams) 6 years
Note: Athletes as young as 4 years of age may participate in pre-competitive events
4. Order of events: All Group Events, BA Short Program, Compulsories Precompetitive Events, All Individual Events, Freestyle and Pair

**We reserve the right to change the order of events, to facilitate movement of the day!*

5. **HOW TO SUBMIT ENTRIES:**

Entry deadline is Feb 9, 2026. (No entries will be accepted after this date.)

Cheques dated no later than February 9th are also welcome. NSF Cheques will be subject to a \$45 service Charge. Cheque amount plus service charge must then be paid either by cash or certified cheque no later than 1 week prior to the event.

ONE CLUB PAYMENT PLEASE

Refunds will only be given if the athlete is unable to participate and a medical certificate is provided. Other illness refunds will be determined on a case-by-case basis. In regards to illness, all current Ontario Covid Guidelines are to be adhered to.

6. In order for an athlete/group to compete in a CBTF Sanction competition all Athletes and coaches must be currently registered members, in good standing, with OBTA/CBTF. All athletes must be coached by a currently registered, CBTF certified coach (T1 or T2) Only certified (minimum BTF TRAINED) currently registered CBTF coaches WITH VSC and athletes still to compete will be allowed in practice gym (No children, no parents). CBTF membership numbers must be indicated on the entry form.

7. **AWARDS:** All results posted in the practice gym for coaches

GRADING SYSTEM: All results will be posted and the awards are as follows:

- Groups 1st to 3rd, individuals 1st to 3rd (1st to 5th in divisions with 10 or more athletes).
- All C and BN divisions from 6-11 years of age are under the CBTF Grading System and are not scored; They will receive a bronze, silver, gold or diamond medal.
- All participants in Basic Match, Forward Motion and Pre-Events will receive their CBTF Ribbon.
- All score sheets will be available for coach pick up at the tabulation table in the dedicated Club Baskets.
- All group score sheets will be available 30 minutes following group events.
- All pre-events score sheets will be available approximately 30 minutes following pre-events competition.
- All individual score sheets will be available approximately 30 minutes following the individual event.
- All freestyle and pair scoresheets will be available approximately 30 minutes following the final freestyle of Pair.
- We will be flashing scores after each individual event, remembering tab room will take penalties off after flashing.

8. **There will be refreshments and food served in the cafeteria.**

9. Medical assistance and First aid will be available on site, as well as reserved mobility seating.

10. Special needs lane will be made available on request. Warm up area will be available

11. Athletes' participation/gym fee- All athletes will be required to pay a participation/gym fee with the entry form. No fee will be charged at the door, and set systems will be emailed to club directors before the competition, and limited copies will be available on the day of the event.

FREE ADMISSION- NO FEE WILL BE PAYABLE AT DOOR!

12. There will be lots of fun activities for the athletes to do!

13. There will be a raffle table with 50/50, Teddy Bear Raffle and others!

14. All athletes must declare any medical support/brace worn for the prevention of injury as deemed necessary by a physician. Copy of medical certificate must accompany entry.

15. The OBTA Risk Management Policy will be maintained and enforced for the duration of the competition. The full policy can be found at www.obta.ca. Please ensure you read the document before the competition.

CBTF Risk Management Policy

- a. The Competition Director or designate and/or the Head Judge shall have the authority to immediately stop the competition whenever a risk factor related to safety becomes evident.
- b. If this situation occurs during individual competition, the competition on the lane where the situation occurs shall be stopped on that lane only by the competition director and/or the judge judging that event.
- c. If an athlete must leave the competition to seek outside medical assistance because of a situation that has occurred during a competition, the athlete shall require a Medical Certificate stating that he/she may continue competing at that competition.
- d. If the situation involves a medical injury or illness (that does not require outside medical assistance), the Competition Director, in consultation with authorized medical personnel, shall determine whether the athlete(s) may be allowed to continue competing.
