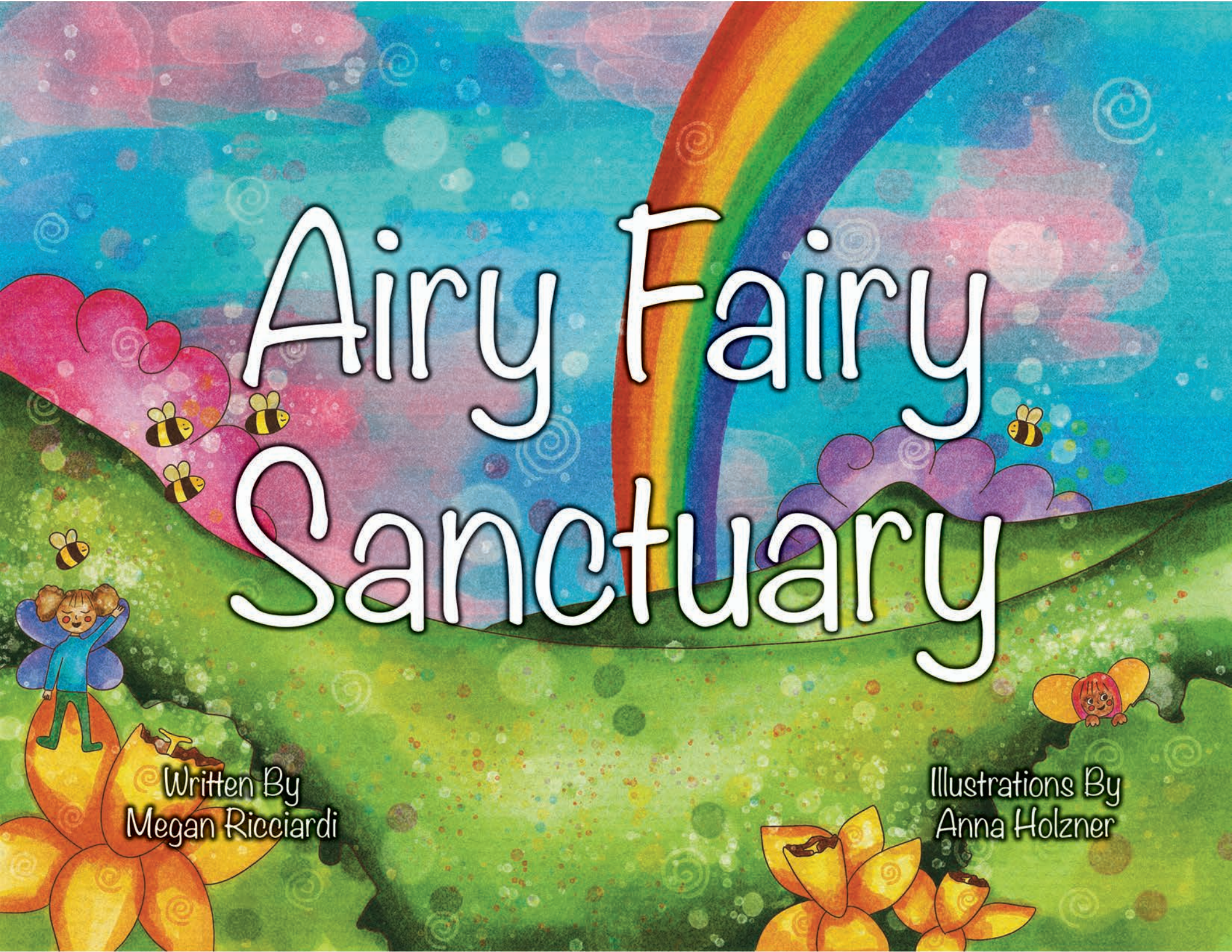

where you can find books, magazines and all things literary.”





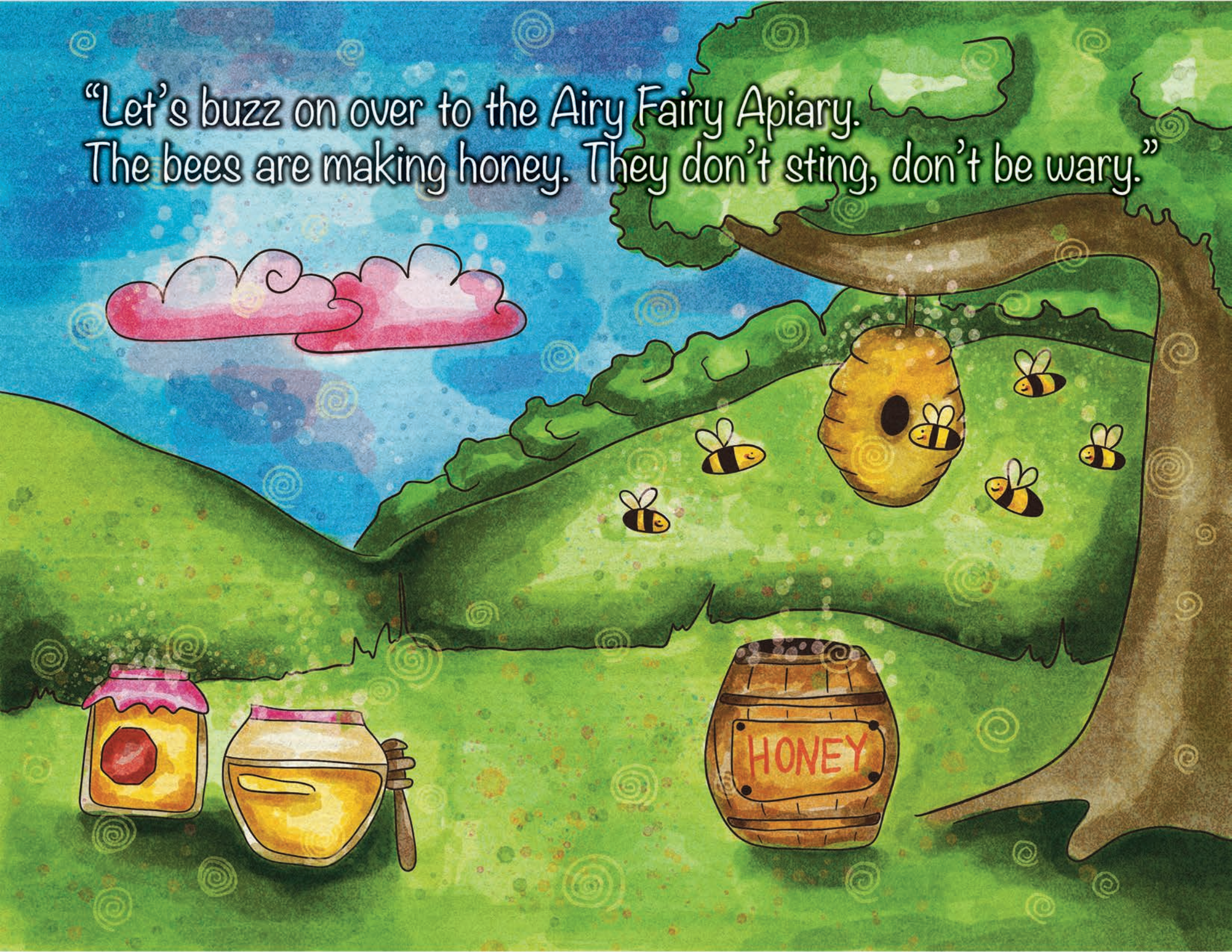
“Let’s go for a ride on the Airy Fairy dromedary.
It’s like a camel, but with one hump and a little less hairy!”





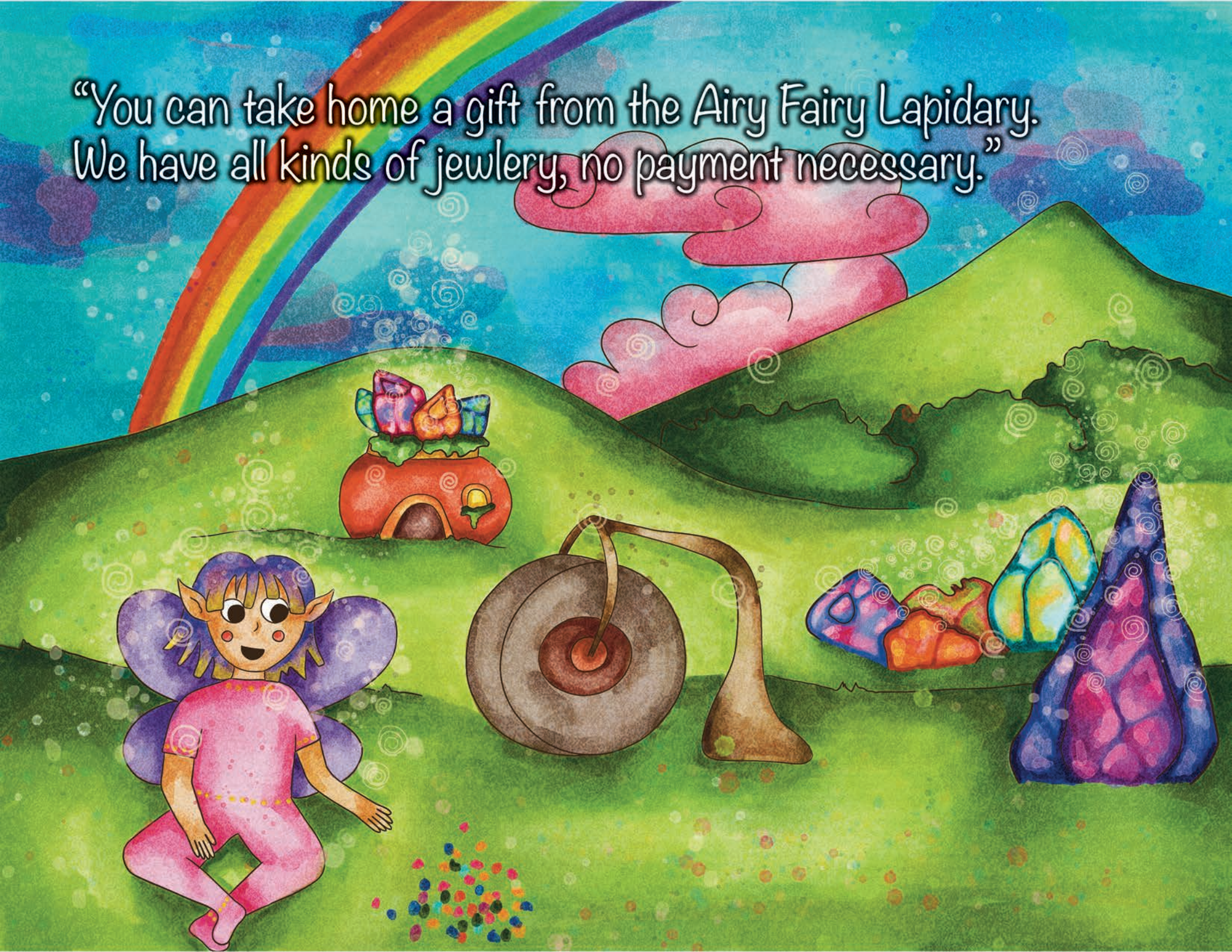


“Let’s buzz on over to the Airy Fairy Apiary.

Airy Fairy Dictionary
