## **OPTIONS FOR EARNING**

Want to travel but need to earn along the way?
You're dreaming of adventure, but you know you'll need to make some money to keep
the journey going long-term. Sound familiar?

The ideal scenario - you've got a laptop and some in-demand skills, allowing you to work from anywhere. But let's be real, that's not always an option. Maybe you're travelling light, heading off-grid, or simply don't have the right tech.

Good news! If you've got a smartphone, there are still plenty of ways to earn on the move using an e-sim. Let's explore some of your options!

#### **TEACHING LANGUAGES**

► You can register to teach English - or another native language - as a foreign language and get paid while travelling!

No Platforms like Palfish, Cambly, and iTalki offer rates between £8 and £23 per hour, depending on your experience and the platform. The more you teach, the higher your earning potential!

Pro tip: Start now as a side hustle to build up your experience (and savings and a steady income stream - and a reputation score that gives access to the highest-paying opportunities!







If you're great at Instagram, TikTok, or Facebook, why not get paid for it? Businesses are always looking for help with content creation, scheduling posts, engaging with followers, and running ads.

§ How much can you earn?

Freelance social media managers can make anywhere from £250 - £800+ per month per client. If you manage just one or two clients, you can make good money while working part-time.

Bonus tips: 1) If you're skilled at creating viral content, growing engagement, or running paid ads, you can charge premium rates. #### **CUSTOMER SERVICE AGENT**

Not as exciting as a secret agent, but if you're good at communicating and problem-solving, remote customer support could be a fantastic way to earn £10 - £15 per hour while travelling! Many companies hire freelancers to handle live chat, email support, or even phone enquiries, all of which can be done straight from your phone.

✓ ModSquad - Offers chat moderation and customer support jobs with a high degree of flexibility. Many roles are fully remote and don't require a fixed location.

✓ LiveOps - Flexible, but you need to be based in the U.S., UK, or Canada when applying. Some roles allow working from different locations after you're hired.

✓ The Chat Shop - Primarily hires UK and U.S.-based agents, but once hired, many roles allow remote work from various locations



### OTHER OPTIONS



Other than working as a freelancer in a specialist field, these are the 3 options likely to pay you the most, all while being location-independent. If you can get started while you're still in the planning stage, you'll have plenty of opportunities to create passive income streams in advance. This will help you build your emergency nest egg and, ensuring your adventure is all work, little play, but the cash keeps rolling in. More on passive income in my training.
