




A picturesque wine region where rolling vineyards, medieval villages, and avant-garde wineries offer an unforgettable blend of history and wine culture.

Day 1: Bilbao

- Explore the vibrant city of Bilbao!

- Tour the iconic Guggenheim Museum, walk our charming old part of town.

Day 4: Rioja Alavesa

- Transfer to San Sebastian, where we will refresh with food and drink at a local cider house.
- Stay overnight at a hotel in San Sebastian.

Day 5: Rioja and Hondarribia

- Travel to Hondarribia, the charming coastal fishing town bordering France.
- Eat fresh fish at the port and quench your thirst with local txakoli.
- Transfer to San Sebastián. With a free afternoon, walk and explore this beautiful city, or unwind with a siesta.
- Stay overnight at a hotel in San Sebastián.

Pay 6: San Sebastián

- Begin the day leisurely with a late wake-up call.
- Walk the town with their local guide. Visit the Basque museum enjoy their markets and indulge in authentic Pintxos at curated, non-touristy spots.
- Enjoy optional activities like surfing lessons, kayaking.
- Dine at a family-run Basque restaurant with a cozy atmosphere.
- Stay overnight at a hotel in San Sebastián.
