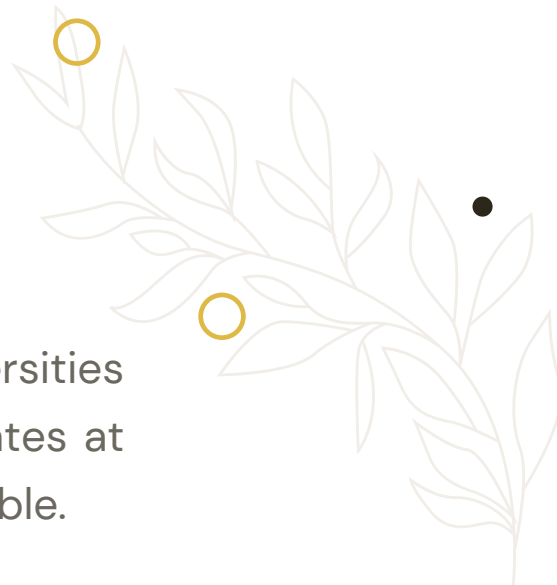

# Who Can Apply?

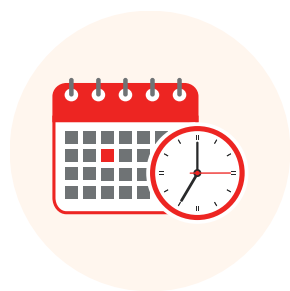
All faculty members of Colleges and Universities and Research Scholars & Research Associates at the Ph.D. or Post-Doctoral level etc. are eligible.
