

# Mode and Delivery of the Programme

The NEP Orientation and Sensitization Programme will be conducted entirely online over eight days, from 27 January 2026 to 4 February 2026.

Each day will include two interactive sessions of 90 minutes each, providing a total of three hours of structured learning per day.

## Guidelines for Participation:

- The live sessions will be conducted through a reliable online platform to ensure smooth access, interaction, and engagement.
- Participants are required to join the sessions using a computer or laptop with a stable internet connection to facilitate uninterrupted participation.
- The programme will feature interactive Q&A sessions to strengthen conceptual and practical understanding. Participants are expected to keep their cameras on and actively engage throughout the sessions.
- 100% attendance is mandatory. Participants must remain present for the entire duration of each session to meet the attendance requirement.
- Active participation is essential to derive maximum benefit from the programme. Participants are encouraged to ask questions, share experiences, and interact constructively with facilitators and peers.
- All programme protocols including attendance, assignment submissions, and ethical conduct must be strictly adhered to for successful completion.
- Certificates of Completion will be awarded only to those participants who fulfill the attendance and participation requirements.
