



Update from your Handicap Chair!



Dear golfers,

This will be my last update as of Handicap Chair and/or as a member of your Board of Directors.

I am stepping down after five very enjoyable years, and I would like to thank you for your support also when my message to you was not exactly what you most wanted to hear!

Looking back, I am proud of what we have accomplished together for the greater good of our game. This year the board incorporated the use of the USGA/GHIN Handicap Audit application, and I'm proud to share that we have gone from almost sixty members in need of an index adjustment six months ago to only twenty-two this time, and of those twenty-two, seven members will be adjusted up, and none of the others require a downward adjustment of more than 0.5 to 1.0!

In other words, the GHIN-system works very well for us, and we largely appear to be very good citizens that post our scores correctly and in a timely manner. In that regard, I would like to – again – urge you to post 'hole-by-hole' in the GHIN-app after the round. That way, the app automatically handles any needed adjustments...

We still have a few 'creative' members, when it comes to forgetting to post an exceptional round here and there, engaging in creative handicap maintenance, and posting scores of rounds imagined but not played. However, also these misdeeds appear increasingly rare!

I thank you all for your help, understanding, and ongoing support over the past few years!

It has been an honor to serve as your Rules Chairman this past year. My hope has been to remain accessible and provide clear, consistent guidance on the written rules that shape the game we love. While golf is governed by rules, the spirit of the game defines our identity. Respect, integrity, accountability, etiquette, and sportsmanship are the qualities that give golf—and LVMC—its character:

- **Respect:** The course, your fellow players, and the pace of play.
- **Integrity:** Accurate scoring, adherence to the Rules of Golf, and honesty within your group.
- **Accountability:** Ownership of your actions on and off the course as a reflection of LVMC.
- **Etiquette:** Proper conduct, awareness, and consideration at all times.
- **Sportsmanship:** Compete fairly, win with humility, accept loss with composure.

As members, we hold a stewardship responsibility. Everything we touch should be left in better condition than we found it. We repair more than our own ball marks, we pick up more than our own trash. Demonstrate the change you want to see, honor our course and each other.

A reminder on handicaps:

Handicap manipulation in any form—selective posting, intentional poor play, knowingly incorrect entries, or delayed posting—violates both USGA and LVMC rules and undermines the spirit of the game. The handicap system exists to ensure fair competition. It only works when every member participates with honesty and consistency, and protects each other.

Handicap manipulation deemed to exceed the spirit of the game will have consequences in the coming year.


