While John had no concept of danger, Caleb had a debilitating fear of heights. He understood the danger of the electrical tower but without the slightest hint of hesitation, he chose to follow his brother up after calling for help. 10

When he finally reached his brother, Caleb held on to him tightly with his right hand while grasping one of the metal bars with his left. He was trembling from the cold and his fingers were numb, but he refused to release his grip on John. John struggled, desiring to climb higher. After seeing Caleb trembling, John also gave in to the cold wind and hugged Caleb. Minutes seemed like hours. Caleb sang songs to soothe his own racing heart while trying to keep both warm. 15

Hundreds of people had gathered at the base of the tower. They looked like ants from the top. Noisy news helicopters began circling the tower, sending images of the two boys clinging to the tower against a bright blue sky to millions of television sets nationwide. Meanwhile, one brave firefighter had scaled the structure to where the brothers hung on for their lives. He quickly secured them to a safety line and lowered them to the ground. 20

The crowd cheered and applauded Caleb as a hero. Caleb did not bask in their praise but stayed by his brother's side. Both were hurriedly transported to the hospital to be treated for exposure to the cold. 25

Not all guardian angels have feathered wings and golden halos. Most would not be recognised, yet they persist in protecting and watching over others. Without a doubt, hundreds of people had caught a glimpse of one that afternoon. 29
