

Maja, an eight-year-old girl, had been watching the injured bottlenose dolphin, named Flipper, swim around the tank. From a distance, the dolphin seemed approachable enough. Still, as Maja prepared to take the plunge, she felt a sense of fear. What would the dolphin do?

Three years ago, during a war in Yugoslavia, Maja was badly injured when a bomb exploded near her. Her left leg was beyond repair. The doctors had to amputate her leg below the knee. Since then, Maja hobbled around using crutches and her one good leg. 5

After the incident, Maja could never find a good fit for an artificial leg. The artificial legs available were also too heavy for her. She could not enjoy doing her favourite sports without tremendous pain. She started to get frustrated and when she saw other children running around playing happily, she could not help but feel bitter at her inability. 10

Once, when Maja's parents took Maja to visit the aquarium in a bid to cheer her up, she spotted Flipper. It was being fitted with a man-made tail which was durable yet light. The material it was made of could also protect the dolphin's delicate skin. Flipper swam around the enclosure with its new tail effortlessly.

An idea struck Maja. She turned to her parents excitedly and made them promise they would do their best to help her. Maja's parents got in touch with the inventors of the new dolphin tail. Within one month, they received positive news. Their perseverance has paid off! 15

As Maja slowly eased herself into the pool to swim with Flipper, her parents watched with bated breath. They heaved a sigh of relief when Maja swam up to Flipper and together, they swam gracefully around the enclosure with their man-made tail and limb, bringing tears to the eyes of the spectators watching them. 20
