Utilizing specialized coastal tractors to deliver international-level cleanliness and restore Bali's pristine beaches.

Strategically Organized Operations:

A well-coordinated fleet managed by a 24/7 operations center to ensure effective and seamless waste management.

Job Creation:

Providing employment opportunities through beach monitoring, waste management systems, and operational support roles.

AI-Driven Efficiency:

Leveraging artificial intelligence to optimize coverage, reduce traffic congestion, and minimize pollution, ensuring smarter and greener waste management practices.
