The only money we get from the school is for travel. Every year we get 13,500 for busing-use it or lose it. Concessions are taken out. 24,120.53 is what the season cost for 2020. Total amount raised by the students was short 7741.29. We will need to vote on to determine if we will cover the difference. Last year we met the goal.

Impacts: Color-guard uniforms would have to be paid for on own, miss competitions, no new silks, could be covered if we didn't hire marching band staff-but they are needed.

Build small committee to cover for the future-push students to fund-raise and plan for the every 4 years to cover the trip year.
