Director Notes

Happy August, Warriors!

The Marching Band has been working tirelessly to get our show underway and the weather has been beautiful! However, we are expecting INTENSE heat during our second week of learning. As coaches, we will keep an eye on the heat index and make decisions on when to be outside and inside. The fact is, though, we will need to be outside to finish learning our show, so water and food will be EXTRA important this week. We will take frequent water breaks for everyone's safety.

Heat aside, we are excited to show you everything we have learned at our "First Look" event on Tuesday, August 9! Bring all your friends and extended family - the show takes place at Howard Wood Field. Students will start rehearsal at 5PM, with the official show run-through at 7PM. Other marching band events to be aware of:

HOWARD WOOD RETREAT

Saturday, August 6 - 1 to 9PM @ Howard Wood Field

BE PREPARED: As always, make sure students eat lunch before coming, bring plenty of water, and wear sunscreen. Dinner break is from 5PM to 6:30PM. Your students have a couple of options for their dinner break:

FAST FOOD: Students who drive can leave/carpool from HWF to go somewhere for dinner. There are few options close to HWF but there is a Burger King, gas station, and a Subway.

LUNCH BAG: Students can bring food for dinner and stay on site to eat.

ORDER PIZZA: For anyone interested, we will be or-

dering pizza for those who wish to stay on site and eat. If this is the option your student would like, we will have a sign-up in the band room this week. You can also email Mrs. Coyne this information. Each student who wants pizza will need to contribute \$5. Students will receive 4+ pieces of pizza - either pepperoni, cheese, or veggie. A few Uniform Checkout notes:

- Marching Shoes The group marching band order has already been sent in, but the shoes most likely will not arrive in time for Uniform Checkout Day. To make sure your pants are adjusted to the correct length, please wear soled shoes at your designated time. If you have not ordered shoes yet, you can still purchase them online by searching for DSI Marching MTX Black.
- Gloves All wind players are required to wear black gloves (not percussion or color guard).
 Each pair is \$3 and we suggest buying at least two pairs to last the season. We have these in stock in the band room, and they can be purchased on uniform check-out day on August 8.

The raffle & auction consists of organizing and securing donations (with the help of volunteers) to use as raffle items and create auction packages. The process of securing donations starts in early summer.



Fundraising – work with directors on ideas for monthly fundraisers, sign up for Weisser Distributing dates, create the volunteer sign-ups for them if needed. Many fundraisers we repeat every year but the fundraiser committee leader will research and secure other possible fundraising opportunities.

Fundraising Opportunities

Hy-Vee cards are also sold at Band Booster meetings, band concerts and other events.

INTERSTATE BATTERIES – We have packs of 24 – AA & AAA batteries available. The packs sell for \$15 each and the students receive a profit of \$9-\$10 on 1) each pack sold. The battery form is available online and batteries are sold at Band Booster meetings, Band concerts and other events.

SCRIP CARDS – WHS Band Boosters orders gift cards at a discount. Families pay face value for the cards and the difference is an instant rebate for your student's fundraising account.
