IMPORTANT Pre-Season Steps

There are a couple things your student needs to participate in the WHS Marching band (checks can be made out to "WHS Bands" and turned in to one of the directors)

- Marching Shoes these are ordered by the directors, but we need to know what size. Please have order forms filled out and returned to the director ASAP. If you do not have an order form, one can be found in the <u>Band Shared Drive</u> on our website under Parent Resources.
- Gloves All wind players are required to wear black gloves (not percussion or color guard). Each pair is \$3 and we suggest buying at least two pairs to last the season. We have these in stock in the band room and can be purchased on uniform check-out day on August 8.
- Uniform Deposit Fee is required by all FIRST-YEAR students. It is a one-time fee of \$25.00 to help cover the cost of potential lost items and/or dry cleaning the uniforms each summer. Once you pay it once, you are good for all four years!
- Chaperone If you are interested in being a chaperone for ANY event this year, please contact our chaperone chair to be put on the list (janijq97@gmail.com). We have an informational meeting in August where you can learn about what it means to be a chaperone and then sign up for events (even just one football game!).
- Pit Crew Also, to be part of Pit Crew, for building sets and/or helping get equipment on/off the field at competitions, please contact Lars Fladmark (<u>larsfladmark@gmail.com</u>).

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BAND BOOSTERS AND PARENT VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

All parents of band students are automatically members of the band booster. Band booster meetings are held the second Monday of each month at 7 p.m. We typically meet in the WHS band room.

COMMITTEE LEADERS:

Parent Preview – this event held in August to preview the marching band show. Committee leader will organize the dinner.

- Band Card Coordinator Coordinator will contact the businesses that were on the 2021-2022 band card to invite them to participate again in 2022-2023 and verify the discount they'd like to offer. There is a spread-sheet from past years that can be updated and includes contact information for each business. Heather DeWit is happy to design the card again based on the list provided by the coordinator and will send the card to print. Band Card Coordinator will then put cards in envelopes for students and send thank you notes to participating businesses. There will be some assistance available to the Band Card Coordinator from another band parent.
- Indoor Show Dinner & Raffle/Auction this is the culmination of our marching band season and is held during the Indoor Marching Band Show. Ideally this event is would have co-leaders. Committee leaders organize the dinner and ensure there are volunteers to work the event. The raffle & auction consists of organizing and securing donations (with the help of volunteers) to use as raffle items and create auction packages. The process of securing donations starts in early summer.

Fundraising — work with directors on ideas for monthly fundraisers, sign up for Weisser Distributing dates, create the volunteer sign-ups for them if needed. Many fundraisers we repeat every year but the fundraiser committee leader will research and secure other possible fundraising opportunities.

Pick-up will be at the school if a Band Concert or band event is occurring on the scheduled pick-up night.

Fundraising Opportunities

There are many opportunities throughout the year (including during the summer months) to raise funds for the band and for your individual student's fundraising account. Here are the upcoming and ongoing fundraisers:

HY-VEE CARDS – Earn funds when buying your groceries! That's right – you can earn fundraising money just by purchasing Hy-Vee cards to fund your regular grocery store shopping. Hy-Vee cards are also sold at Band Booster meetings, band concerts and other events.

INTERSTATE BATTERIES – We have packs of 24 – AA & AAA batteries available. The packs sell for \$15 each and the students receive a profit of \$9-\$10 on 1) each pack sold. The battery form is available online and batteries are sold at Band Booster meetings, Band concerts and other events.

SCRIP CARDS – WHS Band Boosters orders gift cards at a discount. Families pay face value for the cards and the difference is an instant rebate for your student's fundraising account.
