Hello and happy March!

After a VERY busy February, we are happy to have a little break in March. We still have many upcoming events before the end of the school year so please check those out.

Post All State Band, we now shift gears to All State Jazz Band. Students who wish to audition for All State Jazz Band should have their materials already as we have discussed this many times in class. If they do not, please advise them to see Mr. Harder. All State Jazz auditions are due (recorded) by March 11. Some students will record with their lesson teachers, otherwise, students should plan to get those auditions recorded and submitted with Mr. Harder.

We are also thinking about Marching Band already! We have officially released the theme for our fall 2022 marching band show and now begin the audition process for drum majors, student leaders, and percussion. Drum major and student leader packets have already been distributed. Percussion auditions for battery and frontline will be available in the next couple weeks.

If your student wants to participate in marching band in there is no audition required. Just fill out a commitment form (located in the band room or in the shared drive) by April 1st. We hope many of your students decide to join us this fall as we present "Forged." We firmly believe that the lessons learned in marching band (perseverance, commitment, dedication, time management skills, constructive criticism etc.) are skills that will benefit your students in their future careers and for a lifetime.

If you are new to marching band (or would like to say hi and have a friendly reminder of protocols) we will be speaking about the commitment required of your student for marching band at the **WHS All Activities Night** on **Tuesday, March 22**. The schedule for this night will be emailed out to all parents from WHS Administration as it gets closer. WHS Band will have a table set up in the commons with information about marching band, chaperoning, and pit crew. We will also be presenting a very short program in the band room during the activity rounds including everything you need to know about joining marching band and color guard. We look forward to seeing you there!



Fundraising Opportunities

There are many opportunities throughout the year (including during the summer months) to raise funds for the band and for your individual student's fundraising account. Here are the upcoming and ongoing fundraisers:

HY-VEE CARDS – Earn funds when buying your groceries! That's right – you can earn fundraising money just by purchasing Hy-Vee cards to fund your regular grocery store shopping. The form and more information are at the end of this newsletter and available on our website at <u>washingtonbands.org/hy-vee</u>. Hy-Vee cards are also sold at Band Booster meetings, band concerts and other events.

INTERSTATE BATTERIES – We have packs of 24 – AA & AAA batteries available. The packs sell for \$15 each and the students receive a profit of \$9-\$10 on 1) each pack sold. The battery form is available online and batteries are sold at Band Booster meetings, Band concerts and other events.

SCRIP CARDS – WHS Band Boosters orders gift cards at a discount. Families pay face value for the cards and the difference is an instant rebate for your student's fundraising account. 

On Your Person

- Photo ID
- Phone/Device Charger
- Medication
- Eye glasses, contact lenses
- Head phones
- Mask
- Spending money
- Wear comfortable shoes
- Small Instruments (flutes, clarinets, possibly alto saxophones)
- Neck pillow (if you want)

In Your Carry-on Bag

- Dental and personal hygiene products (toothpaste/brush, facial wipes)
- One change of clothes
- Snacks, chewing gum
- Books/laptops
- Refillable water bottle (must be empty when going through TSA)

In Your Checked Luggage (no more than 45lbs)

- Required Performance attire (WHS Band Orlando T-Shirts [3; provided] and Khaki pants/shorts)
- Shampoo and other shower items (in a plastic bag)
- Sleepwear
- Underwear, socks hosiery
- Clothing for each day of the trip (temperature will be in the mid-80's)
- Comfortable shoes for walking around, sandals for the beach
- Miscellaneous: Nail file, band-aids, safety pins, bobby pins, hair ties
- Umbrella/Poncho
- Swimwear & cover-up
- Sunscreen!
- Lightweight coat or jacket
