Director Notes

Happy October!

As we are nearing the end of our marching band season, I would like to say a huge THANK YOU to all the parents that have made our season so successful. Our students have worked so hard and that is apparent in the quality of the show they are performing. But it takes a village of parents who are also working hard to make this operation run. We cannot do it without you. Thank you for building props, chaperoning, sewing new silks at the very last minute, loading trailers, traveling with us, volunteering at Festival of Bands, and making sure your kids are where they need to be, when they need be. Thank you for your support!

We are not done yet! This weekend we are traveling to Lincoln, NE for our return to the Lincoln Links competition and then closing our competitive season with our performance at the dome in Vermillion (ITINERARIES, page 2; CALENDAR, page 3). Both should be outstanding shows; the sound in the dome will be incredible! Itineraries for these events are in the shared drive on the website. A reminder that there is **NO SCHOOL** on **Monday** or **Tuesday**, **October 10** and **11**, so we will not have rehearsal on those days – just on Thursday, October 13.

Also, if our football team makes playoffs, we will be in the stands playing Pep Band for the game but WILL NOT perform our halftime show. **Playoffs** are **TBD** but would happen on **Thursday, October 27**. Marching band students should keep this date open in case we play the game.

- **12:45 PM** Arrive at lunch location You choose: Target Grocery, Chick-fil-A, Raising Canes, McDonalds, McAlister's Deli
- 1:45 PM Load bus and depart for Lincoln High School, Lincoln, NE 2229 J St, Lincoln, NE 68510
- 2:00 PM Arrive at Lincoln High School, Lincoln, NE
- 2:15 PM Unload instruments and get into uniform!
- 2:50 PM Group ensemble warm-up begins
- 3:50 PM Depart warm-up site for staging

Fundraising Opportunities

There are many opportunities throughout the year (including during the summer months) to raise funds for the band and for your individual student's fundraising account. Here are the upcoming and ongoing fundraisers:

HY-VEE CARDS – Earn funds when buying your groceries! That's right – you can earn fundraising money just by purchasing Hy-Vee cards to fund your regular grocery store shopping. The form and more information are on **page 6** of this newsletter and available on our website at <u>washingtonband.org/hy-vee</u>. Hy-Vee cards are also sold at Band Booster meetings, band concerts and other events.

INTERSTATE BATTERIES – We have packs of 24 – AA & AAA batteries available. The packs sell for \$15 each and the students receive a profit of \$9-\$10 on 1) each pack sold. The battery form is available online and batteries are sold at Band Booster meetings, Band concerts and other events.

SCRIP CARDS – WHS Band Boosters orders gift cards at a discount. Families pay face value for the cards and the difference is an instant rebate for your student's fundraising account. 
Using the New Online Calendar
