

This type of pain can arise from various causes, including injury, overuse, inflammation, degenerative conditions, or systemic diseases.
Hip and Knee Replacement Surgery	Knee and hip replacement surgeries are orthopedic procedures aimed at relieving pain and restoring function in joints that have been severely damaged by arthritis, injury, or other conditions.
Articular Injections (Hyaluronic Acid & PRP)	Articular injections, specifically those containing substances like hyaluronic acid (HA) and platelet-rich plasma (PRP), are minimally invasive procedures used in the management of joint pain and dysfunction.
Fracture Treatment	Fracture treatments encompass a range of medical interventions aimed at stabilizing and promoting healing of broken bones. Fractures can occur due to trauma, overuse, or underlying medical conditions, and require proper management to ensure optimal recovery.
Orthopedic Trauma	Orthopedic traumas refer to injuries involving the musculoskeletal system, such as fractures, dislocations, sprains, and strains. The treatment of orthopedic traumas typically involves a combination of approaches aimed at relieving pain, promoting healing, restoring function, and preventing complications.
NEW! Stem Cell Therapy	Stem cell therapy is a form of regenerative medicine that utilizes stem cells to repair, replace, or regenerate damaged cells, tissues, or organs within the body. 


