President's Report

Rugby was back in Fort McMurray, and it is still growing and evolving as we try to reach more people.

For the Seniors there was Winter indoor touch rugby, and some training incorporated. We had a Knights Women and Men's team representing the club at Rugbyfest. Unfortunately, we were unable to field a Knights Female or Male team for the 2025 season due to low numbers. There were clubs interested in combining but it did not come to fruition. This is an area that we will work on for 2026 in terms of recruiting and club engagement. If numbers are low again, we will help facilitate joining up with other teams so interested players can get some game time/experience.

Our Mini and Junior programs have kids aged 4-17 years old and we ran 3 seasons in 2025. The Winter season we had 30 kids registered, the Spring season we had 51 kids registered and in our 2025 Fall season we had 25 kids registered. In 2025 we had a High School boys 7s team of 9 players that competed in a tournament in Athabasca and went 2 wins and 2 losses. Only 2 boys have ever played rugby before and they are all excited for this upcoming season. We had our first ever U15 Girls team that went and competed in the Edmonton Jamborees as our very own Knights team! We continued to have players from our Mini and Junior programs travel down and represent our club at the Spring and Fall Jamborees. We have had players representing our club at Rep Team level and even at the U18 Canada Camp. Coach Joseph Atalifo and his team are doing a great job building a foundation for all these Minis and Juniors and we hope that they will continue to play this game we all love.

We held a few socials at Banquet to watch the Women's World Cup games and the Men's home game and Buggers for Boobies was held in September. These social events are what helps keep people engaged and we will look to hold more in 2026 and a Family Day event.
