Dry Ration Kit Distribution Programme for People Affected by Covid -19 Lockdown Hyderabad, Telangana.

Background:

Due to Pandemic COVID-19, total Country came under lock down as stated by Government, from 25th March, in this lock down the worst affected are the migrant labours, Rag pickers, Construction workers and less privileged or Below poverty line (BPL) families, for whom daily work then only food, it is the situation all over, there is no food to eat for such people.

Coming to Telangana especially Hyderabad slums where we are working with these people, lot of them are migrants, daily labours, construction workers, factory workers, rag pickers etc., for them survival has become difficult, no work no money no food. We have approached some of the Donors to come for help, but that was not sufficient.

Then we felt happy hearing from SMILE wants to help the needy by supporting them by providing Dry ration kits, we have kept the proposal for at least 500 families for whom the ration is required, but unfortunately, we could get confirmation for only 250 Families. We are very grateful and thanks to S& P Global foundation and smile foundation for involving us implementing partner for this noble cause to help the needy in view of covid 19 crisis.

Pre Distribution Planning:

Before getting approval we have done survey and listed all the dry ration required families and handed over to the Programme Officer, as we got the guidelines and SOP about how to wgo about, we have standardized the activities, first we went to the local police station and met the SHO and got the permission from them that we will conduct such activities and informed SMILE.

We have given clear picture and background of the Area profile where we will be taking up this activity, which has been kept in the proposal for this we have selected Rasoolpura slum where we are implementing Smile Foundation Supported skill training programme . We have met the local leaders took their permission and we have completed all the pre arrangements with the support of trained volunteers which are required for smooth conduct of the program.

We have received the raw materials on 10/08/2020. On 11th August with the help of volunteers we have keep the all the items in one big bag for the benefit of beneficiary to carry in easy way. So we have given dates for distribution on 12/08/2020 & 13/08/2020 in Rasoolpura Slum Area. There are about 15000 families residing in the area, from there we have selected the utmost needy and shortlisted 250 families. We have given them tokens before only so that at the time of distribution disturbances will not come.

Mr. Sridhar and Kishore project Officers from Smile foundation, Hyderabad and Mr. Shaik Nayeem representative from AKMES take the lead role to start the Dry ration kit Distribution programme.

Place: Krishna Nagar, Rasoolpura, Hyderabad

Time: 10:30 am to 4:30 pm

As said earlier before day only we have distributed the tokens to the eligible families, on this day morning we have went there told them to clean the premises done the markings, took the help of volunteers made the arrangements for transport the kits have arrived on time. We have informed them about the safety measures to be taken to safe guard ourselves from COVID-19, distributed the masks to all the people in the families. For volunteers given them hand gloves and protective gear. With the support of volunteers informed them to maintain self-distancing and told to wear the masks which we have given.

Informed them the procedures that one by one should come and give the token and should carry photo copy of Aadhar and sign on the form and then take the kit. (The list of beneficiaries enclosed with this report)

Under the guidance and supervision of Mr. Sridhar & Kishore representatives from Smile Foundation , Hyderabad we have started Dry ration kits programme for Poor and needy in Rasoolpura area people on 12/08/2020 and continued 13th August also and distributed 250 needy families as planned earlier, most of the people have maintained social distancing and cooperated with us..

They all felt happy and thanked S& P Global Foundatin and SMILE Foundation for the support and said they will never forget this help. Especially women members were happy that for one month this ration will be sufficient and said that not even Government is doing any help as you people are doing.

Monthly she is getting only Rs.6000. Due to lockdown the small shopping marts are not working and closedown. Hence she unable to maintain her family. She has two daughters. They are studying in Government school. She is the main bread winner for her family. Very poor hindu family.

Current situation:

Due to lock down she lost her job in shopping mall and unable to get any work and unable to feed her family. That is the reason we have identified her and given the Dry ration kits to her.
