CITIZENS ASSEMBLE AND CHAT EXCITEDLY AMONG THEMSELVES.

CITIZEN ONE (TO THE CITIZENS)

I know, I can't believe it myself.

CITIZEN TWO (TO CITIZEN ONE, LAUGHING)

And Jack Trott is going to kill Blunderbore?

CITIZEN ONE (TO CITIZEN TWO)

That's what I've heard, although it might just be a rumour.

CITIZENS BACK AWAY SCARED, EXCEPT CITIZEN ONE WHO IS DEFIANT AS THEY HEAR FLESHCREEP'S ENTRANCE MUSIC. FLESHCREEP ENTERS

FLESHCREEP (TO THE AUDIENCE)

Give me a chance, I haven't done anything yet.

CITIZEN ONE (TO FLESHCREEP)

Fleshcreep, when will you ever learn that you are not welcome in Dingly Dell.

FLESHCREEP MOVES C AND CITIZEN ONE ASSURES THE OTHER CITIZENS TO REMAIN CALM AND THEY DO NOT RETREAT.

FLESHCREEP

(TO CITIZENS)

Did I hear correctly? Is Jack plotting to kill the giant? (TO HIMSELF, WHISPERING)

That's given me an idea. Once Blunderbore is out of the way, I'll be able to steal my Master's magic harp, not even Spider-Man or Captain America will be able to stop me. (EVIL LAUGH)

CITIZEN TWO (TO FLESHCREEP)

Return everything you've ever stolen.

CITIZEN ONE

We can all live in peace once Blunderbore is defeated.

CITIZEN TWO

And besides in a pantomime when have you ever heard of the baddie not being outwitted?

FLESHCREEP (TO CITIZEN TWO)

In this version of Jack and the Beanstalk, I win.

CITIZEN THREE (TO FLESHCREEP)

Then you mustn't have read your copy of the script.

FLESHCREEP

Silence!

(TO THE AUDIENCE)

And if you do not stop booing and hissing at me, I'll send you to the worst place you could possibly imagine. No, there are far worse places than Preston.

(EVIL LAUGH)

I'd best get going; I can't be spending all day talking to you peasants, I've got to visit the Trott family. Unless they pay their rent today, they will be....

FLESHCREEP GIVES AN EVIL LAUGH AND MOVES L AS IF TO EXIT

...Mind your own business

FLESHCREEP EXITS L AND AUDIENCE REACTS

CITIZEN ONE (TO THE AUDIENCE)

He really does make my flesh creep. (TO THE CITIZENS)
Get it? Flesh creep?

THE CITIZENS LAUGH

SONG 1: WELCOME TO THE BEST DAYS OF YOUR LIVES

CITIZENS

WELCOME TO THE PANTO.
NOW IT'S REALLY STARTING
MAKES YOU FEEL SO GLAD THAT YOU'RE ALIVE
FINALLY, WE'RE FREE NOW.
NOTHING HERE TO FEAR NOW
MAKES YOU FEEL ALL FUZZY DEEP INSIDE

SO, WE CLAP AND SING. LET THE BELLS NOW RING YOU HAVE TO SMILE. IT'S THE TIME

WELCOME TO THE BEST DAYS OF YOUR LIVES THAT HAPPY FEELING MAKES YOU REALISE THAT THE EVIL'S GONE, SO, THE SONG GOES ON WELCOME TO THE BEST DAYS OF YOUR LIVES

FAR FROM GRIEF OR SORROW,

DAME

(OFF)

Help! Police! Murder! Somebody call Inspector Gadget!

CITIZENS ARE CONCERNED. DAME ENTERS L AND VERY UPSET, MAKES A HAND GESTURE TO OFF AND ENTRANCE MUSIC IS PROMPTLY STOPPED.

THE CITIZENS SURROUND HER

(TO THE CITIZENS)

I've just had the most terrifying experience. -

CITIZENS ARE CONCERNED

....I've been followed - followed by two men.

CITIZENS ARE MORE CONCERNED

(TO THE AUDIENCE, REALISING)

It doesn't sound that bad when you put it like that, does it?

THE CITIZENS LAUGH

(TO THE CITIZENS)

So, what's with all the excitement? I could hear you singing from miles away?

CITIZEN ONE

(TO DAME)

Then you haven't head?

DAME (TO CITIZEN ONE)

If you mean the rumour that X is going to be once again known as Twitter and merge with Facebook and Youtube -

CITIZEN TWO

(TO DAME)

Really? Do you have any idea of what the new name will be?

DAME

(TO CITIZEN TWO)
You....Face

CITIZENS LAUGH

CITIZEN ONE

Jack is determined to defeat Blunderbore.

DAME (TO CITIZEN ONE)

My son couldn't batter a sausage if he worked in a fish and chip shop.

CITIZENS LAUGH

CITIZEN ONE

And the Royal family are visiting Dingly Dell.

DAME (TO HERSELF)

The King?

(TO CITIZEN ONE)

What time are they expected to arrive

CITIZEN ONE

Shortly after 11am

DAME (TO THE AUDIENCE)

That should give me enough time to make myself beautiful and look 20 years younger.

CITIZEN ONE (TO THE CITIZENS)

Beautiful and 20 years younger? If the pantomime were Cinderella, she could play one of the ugly sisters.

CITIZENS LAUGH AND DAME IGNORE THE REMARK

DAME (TO THE CITIZENS)

We must find Jack and tell him the exciting news. You know how much in love he is with the Princess.

CITIZENS MAKE A QUICK EXIT IN DIFFERENT DIRECTIONS IN SEARCH OF JACK. DAME MOVES DC

(TO THE AUDENCE)
Hello, everybody!

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

You can do better than that. I said "hello, everybody!"

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

My name's Dame Trott and it's lovely to meet you all. Have any of you seen my son, Jack?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Well, not to worry, I'm sure my friends will find him. I live with Jack and our beloved cow Buttercup. We don't have a large family tree. We can't even afford a plant pot. I did have a husband. It was love at first fright. We were happily married for 10 years and were about to celebrate our 25th wedding anniversary soon after he passed away. He was well known among the locals for his beautiful blue glass eye. I didn't realise it first; it just came out during the conversation. I managed to catch it before it hit the ground. He said I was the only girl to catch his eye.

THUNDER AND LIGHTNING AND DAME REACTS WITH LITTLE CONCERN

BLUNDERBORE (OFF)

Fee-fi-fo-fum, I smell the bones of an Englishman, Be he alive, or be he dead, I'll grind his bones to make my bread!

DAME

Don't be afraid. That was Blunderbore, the evil giant, but we're quite safe here in Dingly Dell. (REALISING)

That reminds me, he has teamed up with Fleshcreep, who demands I pay him rent every month despite me owning my own home, and I want you to boo and hiss whenever you see him. Will you do that for me?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Alright, I suppose if we have to. Will you?

THE AUDIENCE REACTIONS

I'll see you later. I must tell Jack about the Royal visit.

DAME MOVES R AS IF TO EXIT

(TO OFF)
Jack! Jack!

DAME EXITS R. JACK ENTERS L SOON AFTER

JACK

Oh, no, that was my mum. I'm meant to be -

JACK SPOTS THE AUDIENCE

(TO THE AUDIENCE)
Oh, hello, everybody!

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

I said ''hello, everybody!"

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Are you all having a fun time?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Why, what have you been doing? (LAUGHS)

I don't believe we've met before. My name is Jack Trott. What are all your names?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

What was that?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Well, I managed to catch some of them. (POINTING TO A CHILD)
There's Thomas the Tank Engine (POINTING TO ANOTHER CHILD)
Spider-Man and (TO AN ADULT)
what was your name again?

THE ADULT REACTS

And your last name?

THE ADULT REACTS AND JACK REPEATS THEIR LAST NAME

That means very clever and good-looking. Remind me of your first name?

THE ADULT REACTS

Oh, dear, that means not very.
(LAUGHS)
I'm only joking, we're all friends now.
(TO AUDIENCE)
Who here has ever been in love?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

I did have a girlfriend, we met at the fairground while bungee jumping, and she was on the rebound. But not long after she left me to become an astronaut. She said something about wanting more space. And now I am in love with the most beautiful girl in the whole world, No, not Katie Price, it's Princess Jill. I just hope she isn't like all the other girls I've known coz they all say I'm lazy.

(REALISING)

Here, I just had a brilliant idea, and I'm hoping you lot can help me. I doze off whenever the word work...

JACK BECOMES TIRED YET REMIANS AWAKE

....is mentioned. So, when I do, I'd like everyone to yell out my favourite food, pizza, which should wake me up. Will you do that for me?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Will you?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

You will, that's brilliant. Let's have a little practice then, shall we? Okay. So, I just arrived home from attending panto rehearsals and my mother says, "why were you late for work, Jack?"

JACK FALLS ASLEEP, THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND HE WAKES UP

That was okay, but I'd like everyone up Blackpool Tower to be able to hear you. At school, my teacher says, "where's your homework, Jack?".

JACK FALLS ASLEEP, THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND HE WAKES UP

DAME (TO OFF)

Yahoo! Are you there, Jack!

JACK

Oh no, I'd better get going before she catches me here, as I'm meant to be washing up all the cheese slices and then I've got work.

JACK FALLS ASLEEP, THE AUDIENCE REACTS. AND JACK AWAKENS AND MOVES R AS IF TO EXIT, DAME ENTERS L AND JACK AND DAME MOVE C

DAME (TO JACK)

Jack, there you are. I've got some exciting news

JACK (TO DAME)

I know about the Royal Family visiting Dingly. I'm going to marry the Princess.

DAME

(LAUGHS)

Princess Jill?

JACK

It's true, no joke. I'm going to gift her my most recent invention and once she shows the King, he won't be able to resist allowing me to wed his daughter.

DAME

(LAUGHS)

Jack, your inventions are unique and entertaining, yet they are completely useless, which is why no one ever takes them seriously and we are still poor.

JACK

But I've created a number of new gadgets, one of which allows you to see through solid walls and -

DAME

That does, I must say, sound like an excellent idea. What's it called?

JACK

A window.

DAME (TO THE AUDIENCE)

Jack has wasted so much of his life creating wacky sci-fi inventions.

JACK

That's not true. Take it back!

DAME (TO JACK)

Yes, it is, the time machine alone set you back 15 years. What about that fool-proof burglar alarm you were telling me about? You probably still haven't finished it.

JACK

I did, but someone broke in and stole it.

DAME

You'll never going to succeed in your quest to become a successful inventor, Jack.

JACK

But think about it, Mum, we could appear on Dragon's Den, and we'll be famous

DAME

But I don't want to be famous, I want to be (REALISING)

famous? Did you say famous? I've got it, the answer to all our prayers, Dingle Dell's Got Talent. The cash price is £2000. (TO THE AUDIENCE)

I do hope I win, or I won't feel two-ground.

JACK

That's a really good idea. So, what do you have in mind?

DAME (TO JACK)

I could try my hand at stand-up comedy. Do you like local jokes?

JACK

Yeah, their right up my street.

DAME

I told one of our neighbours that me and a friend had been talking about them. He said, "You disgust me". I said yes, we did

JACK

That joke is so terrible it doesn't belong in a pantomime, let alone a talent contest.

DAME

I must put my name down before it's too late.
(TO BUTTERCUP)

Come along, Buttercup. With both of us participating in the talent contest I'm sure we're gonna win.

(TO THE AUDIENCE/JACK)

I'll see you later.

DAME AND BUTTERCUP MOVE L AS IF EXITING

JACK (TO EVERYONE)

Bye and good luck!

DAME AND BUTTERCUP EXIT L

(TO THE AUDIENCE)

I didn't get to show my mum my newest invention, my portable pizza oven. Would you like to see it?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

I said, "would you?"

THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND JACK REMOVES THE PIZZA OVEN FROM HIS BAG

Here it is, my pride and joy.

JACK OPENS THE RIGHT DOOR TO REVEAL THERE IS A PIZZA

When both doors are closed, the cooking process begins.

JACK CLOSES THE DOOR

It shouldn't take more than a few seconds.

JACK OPENS THE RIGHT DOOR TO REVEAL THE PIZZA HAS VANISHED AND THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Oh no, it's vanished to prevent it from over cooking.

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

JACK OPENS THE LEFT DOOR TO REVEAL THE PIZZA HAS VANISHED AND THE AUDIENCE REACTS

What?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

The right door?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

But I've already showed you that side?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Okay.

JACK OPENS THE RIGHT DOOR TO REVEAL THE PIZZA HAS VANISHED AND THE AUDIECE REACTS

Again?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Well, you really should be paying closer attention.

JACK OPENS THE LEFT DOOR TO REVEAL THE PIZZA HS VANISHED AND THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Both at the same time?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Really?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Both doors?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND JACK OPENS BOTH DOORS AT THE SAME TIME TO REVEAL THE PIZZA REALLY HAS VANISHED

See you later

JACK EXITS R.

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 2: TALENT CONTEST - STAGE

DAME AND BUTTERCUP PERFORM A MAGIC ROUTINE

SCENE 3: A QUIET STREET

CITIZENS ENTER R AND MOVE C AND THEY ALL CHAT EXCITEDLY.
KING, PRINCESS, GUARD ONE AND GUARD TWO ENTER R. DAME AND
JACK ENTER L

GUARD ONE (TO DAME/JACK/CITIZENS)

Make way for His Royal Majesty and the Her Royal Highness, Princess Jill.

KING, PRINCESS AND GUARD ONE/TWO MOVE C. CITIZENS, DAME AND JACK MOVE C, QUICKLY AND EXCITEDLY. GUARD ONE/TWO MOVE TOWARDS THEM TO PREVENT THEM FROM GETTING TOO CLOSE TO ROYALTY

PRINCESS (TO THE GUARDS)

Don't be overzealous, they are only excited to meet Royalty.

JACK (TO PRINCESS)

My name's -

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

Jack

JACK

Yes and I've brough you a - (REALISING) how do you know my name?

GUARD ONE (TO JACK)

Her Highness is under no obligation to answer any of your questions.

PRINCESS (TO GUARD ONE)

It's quite alright. I don't mind.

JACK

Please tell me.

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

Your viral Youtube videos, of course.

JACK

Really?

PRINCESS

I especially liked your pizza oven.

JACK PRODUCES A GIFT-WRAPPED BOX FROM HIS BAG AND ATTEMPTS TO GIVE IT TO PRINCESS BUT IS TAKEN BY GUARD TWO. PRINCESS ANGRILY SNATCHES IT FROM THEM AND REMOVES THE WRAPPING PAPER TO REVEAL THE PIZZA OVEN

I love it, but I couldn't possibly accept such an expensive gift.

JACK

But it's one of my own inventions.

PRINCESS

Well, if you're sure.

JACK

I insist and I'm not taking it back.

PRINCESS

Okay, but only on one condition.

JACK (IN LOVE)

I'll do anything for you

PRINCESS

You must accept my gift to you.

PRINCESS BLOWS JACK A KISS BUT KING CATCHES IT AND THROWS IT INTO THE AUDIENCE. PRINCESS BLOWS HIM ANOTHER AND THIS TIME JACK CATCHES IT AND PLACES IT ON HIS CHEEK

JACK (TO HIMSELF)

She kissed me.

(TO PRIENCESS)

I'd like you to meet -

KING (TO PRINCESS)

My dear, we don't have time, we must -

PRINCESS (TO KING)

Please, Father?

KING NODS HIS HEAD WITH FRUSTRATION. DAME STEPS FORWARD

JACK

This is my mother, Dame Trott.

DAME (TO PRINCESS)

It's a pleasure to meet you, Your Royal Highness.

PRINCESS (TO DAME)

You must be very proud of your son.

DAME

Of course. Jack has many more inventions under his belt. Perhaps he could show you when you have more time and -

KING

We really must be on our way. We can't be late for the British Prime Minister.

JACK

Will I ever see you again?

PRINCESS

(TO JACK)

I'm sure our paths will cross.

JACK

I know we've only just met but -

PRINCESS

It feels like a lifetime.

JACK

Yes. Maybe we could go on a date and -

KING (TO JACK)

You most certainly will not. Not even if you defeat the giant and return all of my treasure.

PRINCESS (TO KING)

Please, Father.

JACK (TO KING)

I promise to treat her like a Princess.

KING IS ANGRY

I mean, I'll be a perfect gentleman. I'll hold doors open for her and -

KING

You will not be dating my daughter and that is my final word on the matter.

JACK

Then if I can't date her, can I marry her?

THE CITIZENS LAUGH, BUT KING IS NOT IMPRESSED. PRINCESS IS FLATTERED

DAME (DISMAYED)

Jack!

SONG 2: THE MAGIC OF YOUR SMILE

JACK (TO PRINCESS)

MANY NIGHTS I'VE WISHED AWAY.
THINKING WHERE'S THE GIRL FOR ME
WHEN I FIND THE ONE, I'LL KNOW IT.
SHE'LL BE EVERY DREAM TO ME

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

WHEN I NEET MY PRINCE CHARMING. HE'LL MEAN SO MUCH MORE TO ME AND HE'LL TAKE ME IN HIS ARMS, AND I WILL SEE

JACK/PRINCESS

SO, WHEN WILL I FIND THE ONE THAT
I CAN PIN MY DREAMS UPON
WHEN WILL I SEE THE DREAMER IN THEIR EYES
AND THEN IF HE/SHE TOLD ME SO
I WOULD GIVE MY HEART AND SOUL
FOR THE CHANCE TO FEEL THE MAGIC OF THEIR SMILE

JACK

WHEN I FALL IN LOVE SHE'LL MEAN THE WHOLE WIDE WORLD TO ME AND SHE'LL LOVE AND UNDERSTAND ME. ONE DAY I'LL BELIEVE

PRINCESS

AND WHEN HE COMES, HE'LL SWEEP AWAY THE HARDSHIPS OF THE PAST AND I WILL BE IN LOVE AT LAST

JACK/PRINCESS

SO, WHEN WILL I FIND THE ONE
THAT I CAN PIN MY DREAMS UPON
WHEN WILL I SEE THE DREAMER IN THEIR EYES
AND THEN IF HE/SHE TOLD ME SO
I WOULD GIVE MY HEART AND SOUL
FOR THE CHANCE TO FEEL THE MAGIC OF THEIR SMILE

SO, WHEN WILL I FIND THE ONE THAT
I CAN PIN MY DREAMS UPON
WHEN WILL I SEE THE DREAMER IN THEIR EYES
AND THEN IF HE/SHE TOLD ME SO
I WOULD GIVE MY HEART AND SOUL
FOR THE CHANCE TO FEEL THE MAGIC OF THEIR SMILE

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 4: INSIDE THE TROTT FAMILY HOME - LAUNDERETTE

JACK AND BUTTERCUP ENTER L

JACK (TO THE AUDIENCE)
Hiya, kids!

THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND JACK AND BUTTERCUP MOVE DC. FLESHCREEP ENTERS L, THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND HE MOVES DC

(TO FLESHCREEP)

And what do you want? I do hope you aren't here to collect the rent. My mother and I must use every penny we have to pay the bills. And we were just on our way out to sell milk at the market. Would you be interested in buying a portable pizza oven?

FLESHCREEP (TO JACK)

A portable pizza oven? Your own invention I presume.

JACK

Of course, and it's my last one.

FLESHCREEP

I'm here for one reason only and that is to collect the rent. (REALISING)

Actually, perhaps we could come to another arrangement?

JACK

What did you have in mind?

FLESHCREEP

How about we team up to get rid of Blunderbore?

JACK

But why should I trust you?

FRSHCREEP

Because I detest him as much as anyone else.

JACK

I don't need your help; I'll figure out my own way of defeating the giant.

FLESHCREEP

Even if it meant you didn't have to pay me the rent?

JACK

How about a small wager?

FLESHCREEP

How do you mean?

JACK

I bet you can't answer every question with the same one word.

FLESHCREEP

And if you lose, you'll help me defeat Blunderbore?

JACK

And the rent will be paid today without fail. Do we have a deal?

FLESHCREEP

What's the word?

JACK

Pizza

FLESHCREEP (TO THE AUDIENCE)

That's too easy, I can't lose.

JACK

Then you'll accept the challenge?

FLESHCREEP (TO JACK)

I certainly will.

JACK

Are you ready?

FLESHCREEP

Yes, I am.

JACK

Are you sure?

FLESHCREEP

Yes

JACK

You lose.

FLESHCREEP

How do you mean?

JACK

You didn't say pizza.

FLESHCREEP

That's not fair, I didn't realise we'd begun. Can we not start again?

JACK

Okay. Are you ready now?

FLESHCREEP

Pizza.

JACK

I didn't get you that time, did I?

FLESHCREEP

No, you didn't.

JACK

Thank you. I'll see you next month.

JACK AND BUTTERCUP EXITS. FRSHCREEP IS ANGRY. DAME ENTERS R
AND MOVES DC

FLESHCREEP (TO DAME)

Just the lady I want to see. I've got good news for you; you know how you've always wanted to live in a more expensive house? Well now you can, the rent has gone up.

DAME (TO FLESHCREEP)

Don't be such a tease. Here, I've been thinking that we should get married.

FLESHCREEP

I'm a very busy man.

DAME

What would you say if I asked you for a kiss?

FLESHCREEP

Nothing, it's impossible to laugh and speak at the same time. Look, do you have the rent or don't you?

DAME

I don't have any money of my own.

FLESHCREEP

I don't care whose money it is for as long as it's paid.

DAME

In that case can you lend me £125?

FLESHCREEP

I most certainly will not.

DAME

Even if I were to give you an extra 50?

FLESHCREEP

Well, I guess that's ok.

FLESHCREEP PRODUCES NOTES FROM HIS POCKET AND COUNTS OUT £125 AND HANDS THEM TO DAME

DAME

Thank you.

FLESHCREEP

But I must have it back tomorrow along with the rent or else.

DAME

I can pay you now if you like.

DAME HOLDS UP THE NOTES

FLESHCREEP

You can't pay with that, it's mine.

DAME

But you said it doesn't matter whose money I paid with.

FLESHCREEP

It doesn't, for as long as it isn't my money.

DAME

How about a bet?

FLESHCREEP

And if I win, you don't have to pay the rent?

DAME

Correct.

DAME GIVES FLESHCREEP THE NOTES

FLESHCREEP

Thank you. How about I challenge you to answer every question with the same one word. I bet you can't.

DAME

What's the word?

FLESHCREEP

Banana

DAME

Okay.

FLESHCREEP

Are you ready?

DAME

Yes

FLESHCREEP

Are you sure?

DAME

Yes.

FLESHCREEP

I'll be back at eight for the rent.

DAME

How do you mean?

FLESHCREEP

You didn't say banana.

DAME

That's not fair, I didn't know we had started.

FLESHCREEP

Okay, but this really is your last chance.

DAME

Thank you.

FLESHCREEP

Are you ready this time?

DAME

Yes.

FLESHCREEP GESTURES FOR DAME TO HAND OVER THE NOTES

But I told you I don't have any money. Not until tonight.

FLESHCREEP

All right then, one more go, but this time you had better not get it wrong.

DAME

Thank you.

FLESHCREEP

Are you ready?

DAME

Banana.

FLESHCREEP

Didn't get you that time, did I?

DAME

Banana.

FLESHCREEP

You recently auditioned for Blackpool Community Theatre. How did that go?

DAME

Banana

FLESHCREEP

And I forgot it was your birthday last week and didn't buy you a present. What would you like?

DAME

Banana

FLESHCREEP

You're getting good at this, aren't you?

DAME

Banana.

FLESHCREEP

I don't think I'm going to catch you out, am I?

DAME

Banana.

FLESHCREEP

How about you give me a banana in exchange for the year's rent being waived? How does that sound?

DAME PRODUCES A BANANA FROM HER POCKET AND HANDS IT TO FRSHCREEP AND THEY EXIT THROUGH THE AUDIENCE AS FLESHCREEP CHASES AFTER HER

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 5: INSIDE THE PALACE

BLUNDERBORE (OFF)

Fee-fi-fo-fum!

PRINCESS ENTERS L, SCARED

PRINCESS (TO OFF)

Help! Father! Guardsman!

PRINCESS MOVES C AND JACK ENTERS R

JACK (TO PRINCESS)

Princess Jill, don't be alarmed; Jack Trott, the panto hero, has arrived to rescue you.

JACK MOVES C AND HIM AND THE PRINCESS EMBRACE

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

You must leave here at once.

JACK

After hearing your cries, I had to make sure you were safe. He didn't harm you, did he?

PRINCESS

No, he didn't. I'm more scared than anything. How did you manage to climb the Palace wall?

JACK

That was easy, I used the ladder in my mum's tights.

PRINCESS

But Jack, the guards must have heard my screams and they could return at any moment.

JACK

I just had to let you know that the giant will be defeated.

PRINCESS

But how? I mean even if you did manage to reach Giant Land, you're no match for Blunderbore.

JACK

You don't need to worry about me, I've watched Cobra Kai, and I have a brown belt.

PRINCESS

In karate?

JACK

Well, I dropped it in the gravy whilst I was preparing the Sunday roast.

PRINCESS (LAUGHS)

Oh, Jack.

JACK (LAUGHS)

I'm not sure how, but mark my words, I will end his evil ways and your father's treasure will be returned. I give you, my word.

PRINCESS

I know you mean well, but - oh Jack, wouldn't it be wonderful if you really did defeat Blunderbore?

JACK

But I don't make promises I cannot keep, if I did, I'd become a politician.

PRINCESS

If you do succeed, I'm sure my father will make you and your mother very rich. You know if I could, I would give you enough money to pay your rent and all of your bills, but -

JACK

You really don't need to explain.

PRINCESS

You see, I have no money.

JACK

But you're a Princess.

PRINCESS

It's my father you see, he will never let me have any money of my own, not until I'm married.

JACK STARES INTO PRINCESS' EYES

What? Why do you stare at me like that?

TACK

Because I'm in the love with the most beautiful girl in the whole world.

PRINCESS

Really? Who is she?

JACK

You, of course.

PRINCES

Oh, Jack, what would my father say?

JACK PRODUCES THE SCRIPT AND FINDS THE PAGE HE IS LOOKING FOR

JACK (READING FROM THE SCRIPT)

Jack, for as long as you defeat Blunderbore you can marry my daughter with my blessing.

PRINCESS

It does not say that.

JACK

It does now.

JACK PRODUCES A PEN AND WAVES IT

Oh, Princess Jill, I know we haven't known each other for very long, but I'm in love with you.

PRINCESS

And I've felt the same way about you from the first moment I laid my eyes on you.

JACK

Your father will never give us his blessing.

PRINCESS

But he must, without you, I doubt I'll ever find my true love.

SONG 3: LOST IN YOUR EYES

I USED TO SIT AND DREAM ALL DAY OF A PERSON JUST LIKE YOU.

I USED TO WISH YOU'D WALK MY WAY

BUT I NEVER THOUGHT WOULD COME TRUE

JACK (TO PRINCESS)

AND NOW THAT YOU'RE HERE STOOD BEFORE ME

I CANNOT BELIEVE MY EYES THAT YOU FEEL THE SAME WAY TOWARDS ME. YOU'VE TAKEN ME BY SURPRISE

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

THE WAY THAT YOU LOOK.

THE WAY THAT YOU SMILE TONIGHT

THE MAGIC OF YOU SENDS ALL THIS THRILLS UP MY SPINE

JACK

I'M CAUGHT IN A DREAM.

IT'S JUST LIKE A SCENE FROM A FAIRY TALE FOR TWO.

I'M LOST IN THE MOON AND THE STARS IN THE SKY AND I'M LOST IN YOUR EYES

PRINCESS

SO MANY NIGHTS I SAT ALONE AND STARED OUT TO THE STARS WONDERING IF YOU WOULD EVER KNOW ME.
THEN MAGICALLY HERE YOU ARE

JACK

AND IF ANYONE TRIED TO BREAK THIS MOMENT I WOULDN'T EVEN KNOW THEY WERE THERE COZ IT'S YOU AND ME FOREVER BABY. YOU CAN TAKE ME ANYWHERE

EVERYONE

THE WAY THAT YOU LOOK.
THE WAY THAT YOU SMILE TONIGHT
THE MAGIC OF YOU SENDS ALL THIS THRILLS UP MY SPINE
I'M CAUGHT IN A DREAM.
IT'S JUST LIKE A SCENE
FROM A FAIRY TALE FOR TWO
I'M LOST IN THE MOON AND THE STARS IN THE SKY
AND I'M LOST IN YOUR EYES

JACK

I'M CAUGHT IN A DREAM.

JACK PRODUCES A RING, PROPOSES AND PRINCESS ACCEPTS

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 6: INSIDE THE MARKET

FLESHCREEP ENTERS L IN DISGUISE AS DOCTOR PROCTOR, AND AUDIENCE REACTIS AND HE MOVES C

FRESHCREEP (TO OFF, QUIETLY)

Don't play my entrance music, they're not supposed to know it's me, remember.

(TO THE AUDIENCE)

Gather round, everybody, I'm Doctor Proctor.

CITIZENS ENTER CR AND MOVE DC, AS THEY LISTEN TO FLESHCREEP EXCITEDLY

An inventor of gadgets that will blow your minds.

There's something for everyone, ranging from the world's lightest shovel, it's groundbreakingly, to chocolate teacups.

WEARING COMMON CLOTHES, HAT AND GLASSES TO HIDE HER IDENTIY, JILL ENTERS L ALONG WITH JACK AND BUTTERCUP. THEY LISTEN TO FLESHCREEP EXCITEDLY AS THEY MOVE DC. FLESHCREEP SHOWS THE AUDIENCE A BOTTLE

And my most popular invention to date, a liquid that removes every kind of stain you can think of. Only £5 a bottle. (TO JACK)

Can I tempt you lad?

JACK (TO FLESHCREEP)

No, thank you. I haven't any money, but I do commend you. I'm an inventor myself, you see. Perhaps we could -

FLESHCREEP

No money, eh? Well, what have you got to trade?

FLESHCREEP PATS BUTTERCUP ON HER HEAD

JACK

I could never sell Buttercup, not even if We Buy Any Cow made me a generous offer.

FLESHCREEP PRODUCES A BAG OF GREEN MAGIC BEANS FROM HIS POCKET AND SHOWS THEM TO JACK

FLESHCREEP

This bag of magic beans could change your life forever. I won them in a card game from a medicine man in the circus. Bury these beans and in the morning, they will take you to a land of riches, where you will find the golden treasure that will make you incredibly rich. What do you say?

JACK

Golden treasure?

FLESHCREEP

And incredibly rich.

JACK

So let me get this right, you are going to make me rich and -

FLESHCREEP

Beyond your wildest dreams.

TDCK

But why in exchange for Buttercup? I mean, she is only a cow, after all.

FLESHCREEP

I watched her dancing on TikTok. Se's more valuable to me than all the treasure in the giant's castle.

JACK

And she's a wiz at her ten times table.

FLESHCREEP

Really?

JACK

Well, she is a cowculator.

FLESHCREEP

Do we have a deal, or would you like to phone a friend or ask the audience?

JACK MOVES DC

JACK (TO THE AUDIENCE)
What do you think?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

But this could be my only chance to defeat Blunderbore and prove to the King that I really am worthy of marrying his daughter. Are you sure he can't be trusted?

CITIZENS AND PRINCESS DISAPPROVE AND AUDIENCE REACTS

FLESHCREEP

What if I were to demonstrate their magical abilities to you?

JACK IS INTERESTED BUT UNSURE. FLESHCREEP GIVES JACK A MAGIC BEAN

Swallow that bean and you'll lose your ability to count.

PRINCESS (TO FLESHCREEP)

We don't believe you, but we'd love to be proven wrong.

FLESHCREEP GIVES JACK A MAGIC BEAN. FRUSTRATED, CITIZENS, GUARD AND KING EXIT DR. JACK SWALLOWS THE MAGIC BEAN AND FLESHCREEP PRODUCES THE TOPSY TURVY MAGIC TRICK.

THE TOPSY TURVY MAGIC TRICK ROUTINE: TWO BOTTLES AND TWO TUBES ARE USED. JACK HAS ONE SET AND FLESHCREEP HAS THE OTHER. BOTH COVERS ARE PLACED OVER THE BOTTLES. THEY ARE INVERTED BACK AND FORTH, JACK FOLLOWING FLESHCREEP'S EVERY MOVE. HOWEVER, WHEN THE COVERS ARE RAISED, JACK'S BOTTLE IS THE OPPOSITE WAY UP. THIS IS REPEATED SEVERAL TIMES AND THE DIALOGUE IS IMPROVISED

JACK

(TO FLESHCREEP)
They really are magic beans.

FLESHCREEP HOLDS OUT HIS HAND FOR JACK TO SHAKE IT

FLESHCREEP

Deal or no deal?

JACK

Well, you're no Noel Edmonds or Stephen Mulhern, but yes, it's a deal.

JACK AND FLESHCREEP SHAKE HANDS

FLESHCREEP

Good lad, you know it makes sense.

JACK (TO BUTTERCUP)

Buttercup, go with the nice man, and when I'm rich, I promise to find you and buy you back.

JACK HANDS BUTTERCUP OVER TO FLESHCREEP. JACK AND PRINCESSEXIT R AS THEY GIVE A WAVE TO BUTTERCUP

FLESHCREEP (TO AUDIENCE)

I would have used hypnosis, but I can't risk the fool from awaking from the trance, but should my scheme work, I'll be more powerful than Donald Trump.

FLESHCREEP GIVES AN EVIL LAUGH AND EXITS L

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 7: INSIDE THE TROTT FAMILY HOME - LAUNDERETTE

JACK IS CLEANING THE LAUNDRY AND DAME ENTERS R

DAME (TO AUDIENCE)

Hello, everybody!

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

(TO JACK)

There you are.

DAME MOVES C AND JACK STOPS CLEANING

(TO THE AUDIENCE)

I'm sure he'll grow up to be a policeman, I can never find him. I didn't win the talent contest.

(TO JACK)

How did you do at the market and why are you so late home?

JACK (TO DAME)

You remember Elsa, she attended my old school?

DAME

Of course, I remember her, you dated for a short time. And that's why you're so late? You bumped into her?

JACK

Yeah, she asked me to get her a helium balloon for her birthday, but I told her it wouldn't be a good idea.

DAME

And why not?

JACK

Because she'll let it go, let it go. (LAUGHS)

DAME

Please, Jack, stop larking about and give me the money?

JACK

The real reason for being late is because whilst at Sainsbury's, I was wrongly accused of being a cereal shoplifter.

DAME

A serial shoplifter? I don't believe you.

JACK

Honest, the manager said I hadn't paid for some cornflakes, and Coco Pops (LAUGHS)

No, I met a mysterious man at the market, and he gave me magic beans in exchange for $\mbox{-}$

DAME

(REALISING)
Where's Buttercup?

JACK

I got a good deal for her.

DAME

Magic beans?

DAME SNATCHES THE BEANS FROM JACK

There's no such thing. Oh Jack, I'm so disappointed in you. Just when I thought life couldn't any more complicated you go and prove me wrong.

DAME MOVES L AND THROWS THE BBEANS OFF L

JACK

They were going to change our lives forever.

DAME

That J. K. Rowling has a lot to answer for and you won't be watching the new Harry Potter TV series when come out.

JACK

But we must devise a plan to beat Blunderbore, and if you'll listen to me, I've got one.

DAME LOOKS AT HER WATCH

DAME

The market will be closed now. You'll go back in the morning, and you had better not return empty-handed

DAME EXITS L, CRYING OUT LOUD

FADE-TO- BLACK

SCENE 8: A QUIET STREET

PRINCESS, KING AND GUARDS ENTER R

KING (TO PRINCESS)

No, I won't have it.

KING, PRINCESS AND GUARDS MOVE C

PRINCESS (TO KING)

Please, Father.

KING

I don't want to hear another word on the matter.

PRINCESS

I know all you see is a poor boy, but he's so funny, brave, and -

KING

Incredibly irritating. No, he is not going to amount to anything.
You must avoid him. I'll find you a brave, handsome and (THINKING)

PRINCESS

Funny

KING

I promise you my love, that I will find the ideal husband for you.

PRINCESS

Why, though, when I already have? Father, he truly is the perfect example of a gentleman. Although he may not be the brightest bulb in the box, he is still my Prince Charming. Or at least once we're married, he will be.

KING

The likelihood of that ever happening is 99.99 million to one.

PRINCESS (EXCITED)

Really? You mean I do have a chance?

KING IS ANGRY AND JACK ENTERS R

JACK (TO PRINCESS)

Princess, Jill.

JACK MOVES C AND HE AND PRINCESS HOLD HANDS AT THE ANGER OF KING

KING (TO JACK)

I want you to stay away from my daughter, you're a bad influence.

JACK (TO KING)

Your Majesty, today, Buttercup, my cow was exchanged for magic beans and -

KING

What utter nonsense.

PRINCESS

Father, Jack is going to kill the giant and -

JACK

True, I had them, but my mother didn't believe they were magical, so she tossed them into our garden and now I can't find them. Those magic beans were going to make it possible for all our dreams to come true.

PRINCESS

And my fiancé is not a liar, Father.

KING IS ANGRY

(REALSING HERSELF)

Did I say fiancé? I meant - oh, Father, I'm in love with Jack, and we're getting married with or without your approval.

KING

No one in my family, especially one of my daughters, will ever marry a Trott. You will have to accept that I will never give you her hand in marriage.

JACK

Her hand? What about the rest of her?

KING

No, it's quite out of the question.

KING GESTURES FOR PRINCESS TO EXIT AND THEY EXIT L ALONG WITH THE GUARDS. JACK IS UPSET

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 9: INSIDE THE TROTT FAMILY HOME - KITCHEN

DAME AND JACK ENTER R

DAME/JACK (TO THE AUDIENCE)

Hiya, kids!

THE AUDIENCE REACTS. JACK AND DAME MOVE BEHIND THE TABLE C, WHICH CONSISTS OF A COOKBOOK AND EVERYTHING REQUIRED TO MAKE A CAKE, EXCEPT A COOKER/OVEN. THERE IS ALSO A CARBOARD BOX ON THE TABLE AND JACK IS PLEASED TO SEE IT

JACK (TO DAME)

Mum, Calgon

DAME (TO JACK)

I know she's gone, you gave Buttercup away at the market, and no one has seen that con artist ever since.

JACK

No, Calgon.

JACK TURNS THE CARBOARD BOX AROUND TO REVEAL IT'S CALGON BUT DAME IS NOT IMPRESSED

I've been looking everywhere for it.

DAME

We had better get started on the cake. At £5 per slice, I'm confident we will be able to cover the rent.

JACK PICKS UP THE COOKBOOK

JACK

But I made a deal with Fleshcreep, remember.

DAME

And I bet you tricked him just like I did. No, I can guarantee the rent will have to be paid tonight or we'll be evicted.

JACK

Okay. What sort of cake are we going to be making?

DAME

I believe it's on page 34.

JACK TURNS THE PAGES OVER UNTIL HE FINDS THE CORRECT PAGE AND HE SHOWS IT TO DAME

That's the one.

JACK

It looks yummy.

Dame

It sure does. Though a simple one, this cake is one of my favourites.

JACK (TO HIMSELF, LOOKING AT THE COOKBOOK)
Let's see, what do I add first?

DAME

I'll read the cookbook, and you add the ingredients. I don't want there to be any mistakes.

JACK GIVES DAME THE COOKBOOK

JACK

Okay. Where do I find these greedy ants?

DAME

What?

JACK

And why are they to be added to the bowl? I mean, it's a very strange cake and besides I thought you were a vegetarian.

DAME

What are you going on about?

JACK

You told me to add greedy ants to the bowl.

DAME

Greedy ants?
(REALISING)

No, not greedy ants. Ingredients.

JACK

Ah, sorry, Mum.

DAME

That's okay. It's important that you do exactly as I say.

JACK

Exactly as I say.

DAME

No, do exactly as I say.

JACK

That's what I said, do exactly as I say.

DAME

No, you do what I tell you to do.

JACK

I get it, you do what i tell you to do..

DAME (TO HERSELF)

I give up.

(TO JACK)

Let's begin.

JACK

Okay,

DAME

Add the sugar to the bowl.

JACK

How much do I need to add?

DAME

It's already been measured, so you just need to add it.

JACK ADDS THE SUGAR TO THE BOWL

JACK

Done it.

DAME

Good. Now add the butter.

JACK

Do I add it all?

DAME

Yes.

JACK ADDS THE BUTTER TO THE BOWL

JACK

That reminds me, last week I cut my finger. I put some margarine on it to stop the bleeding, but it didn't help. I said to Buttercup "I can't believe it's not better".

DAME

The butter and sugar should be whisked together until pale and fluffy.

JACK WHISKS THE BUTTER AND SUGAR AND THEN SHOWS DAME THE BOWL

Well done. Now add the flour, half a pound.

JACK EXITS L AND ENTERS CL A FEW MOMENTS LATER HOLDING TWO FLOWERS. HE PRODUCES A FIVE-POUND NOTE FROM HIS POCKET AND ENTERS THE AUDIENCE IN SEARCH OF CHANGE. HE FINDS A FIFTY PENCE COIN IN HIS POCKET AND RETURNS C, BEHIND THE TABLE AND ADDS ONE FLOWER TO THE BOWL

JACK

Here you are, this is for you, a little flower, for being the best mum in the whole world.

JACK HANDS THE FLOWER TO DAME, WHO IS DELIGHTED AND SMELLS IT Did you say half a pound?

DAME

That's right.

JACK PRODUCES A FIFTY PENCE COIN FROM HIS POCKET

JACK

50p is half a pound.

JACK ADDS THE COIN TO THE BOWL

What's next?

DAME

Two eggs.

JACK ADDS TWO EGGS IN THEIR SHELL TO THE BOWL

And be careful to not get any eggshells in the bowl.

JACK REMOVES THE EGGS, CRACKS THEM AND ADDS THE YOLKS TO THE BOWL

JACK

They've been added.

DAME

Now beat it.

JACK (UPSET)
Pardon?

DAME

I said "beat it"

JACK UPSET ENTERS THE AUDIENCE

What are you doing? What are you doing?

JACK

You told me to beat it.

DAME

No, beat the eggs.

JACK

Ah, beat the eggs, silly me.

JACK ENTERS C, BEHIND THE TABLE AND HE USES A SPOON TO BEAT THE EGGS

DAME

Ensure that the eggs are well beaten.

JACK

Okay, will do

JACK BEATS THE EGGS EVEN HARDER THAN BEFORE

All done.

DAME

Add the milk.

JACK

How much do I add?

DAME

Like before, add the full amount.

JACK ADDS ALL THE MILK TO THE BOWL

JACK

What now?

DAME

Get me a couple of dates.

JACK ENTERS THE AUDIENCE AND BRINGS TWO MEN ONTO THE STAGE.

JACK A ASK THEM THEIR NAMES AND FINDS OUT A LITTLE BIT MORE

ABOUT THEM

Jack, what on earth do you think you are doing?

JACK

You told me to get you a couple of dates.

DAME

No, dates that you eat.

JACK (TO THE MEN)

It was great to meet you both, but the pantomime is Jack and the beanstalk, not Cinderella, we don't need two ugly sisters.

JACK GESTURES FOR THE MEN TO RETURN TO THEIR SEATS AND THEY
DO SO

DAME

Jack, will you please behave yourself and get back behind the table.

JACK ENTERS THE STAGE AND MOVES C, JOINING DAME BEHIND THE TABLE

JACK (TO DAME)

It's not fair. I was only chatting to them. You said you wanted a couple of dates. How was I to know you -

DAME

Jack, will you please put a sock in it.

JACK

Pardon?

DAME

You heard, I said "put a sock in it".

JACK REMOVES A SOCK AND PUTS IT INTO THE BOWL

And now using a whisk mix all the ingredients and then it then needs to be placed in a baking tray and finally a quick bake in the oven.

JACK WHISKS THE INGREDIENTS

JACK

I've mixed it.

DAME

Well done. Now give it to me.

JACK

Pardon?

DAME

I said "give it to me"

JACK (TO AUDIENCE)

Should I give it to her?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Are you sure?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND JACK RUNS TOWARDS DAME WITH THE BOWL JACK AND DAME EXIT THROUGH THE AUDIENCE, AS JACK CHASES AFTER HER WITH THE BOWL.

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 10: THE TROTT FAMILY HOME - BEANSTALK IN GARDEN

DAME ENTERS R, CARRYING A SHOPPING BAG

DAME (TO AUDIENCE)

Hiya, kids!

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Here they are, the delicious cakes ready to be sold.

DAME MOVES DC

But I doubt if Jack and I will sell enough slices. Without a miracle, we're going to be homeless.

AUDIENCE REACTS

There's a what?

AUDIENCE REACTS

A beanstalk?

AUDIENCE REACTS

Oh no there isn't!

AUDIENCE REACTS

There isn't!

AUDIENCE REACTS

Isn't! Isn't! Isn't!

AUDIENCE REACTS

Oggy! Oggy! Oggy!

AUDIENCE REACTS

Um-Pah! Um-Pah

AUDIENCE REACTS

Is there really a beanstalk in my garden?

AUDIENCE REACTS AND DAME LOOKS BEHIND HER AND IS SHOCKED TO FIND A BEANSTALK IN THE GARDEN

Jack had been telling me the truth the whole time and to think I accused him of lying.

(TO OFF)
Jack! Jack!

JACK, PRINCESS AND CITIZENS ENTER CL43.

JACK (TO DAME)

I'm here, Mum, and the Princess and our friends are going to help us sell the cake slices.

JACK, PRINCESS AND CITIZENS MOVE DC. PRINCESS AND CITIZENS ARE SHOCKED TO SEE THE BEANSTALK. DAME POINTS TO THE BEANSTALK, AND JACK IS SHOCKED BY WHAT HE SEES

DAME (TO JACK)

I owe you an apology, son. I should have listened to you; they were indeed magic beans.

JACK

I can't believe what I'm seeing, I've never seen stranger things.

DAME

Well, I've got the complete series on DVD and there's always Netflix. Jack, can you ever forgive me?

JACK

Of course I forgive you, Mum.

DAME

Thank you, son; you are a good lad deep down.

FLESHCREEP ENTERS L DISGUISED AS DOCTOR PROCTOR, THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND HE MOVES C. FLESHCREEP IS NOT PLEASED HIS ENTRANCE MUSIC IS BEING PLAYED

FLESHCREEP (TO EVERYONE)

Good evening.

DAME (TO FLESHCREEP)

Do you mind? We're having a private conversation.

FLESHCREEP (TO DAME)

I do apologise.

JACK

Mum, this is Doctor Proctor. He gave me the magic beans and -

DAME

I'm so sorry.

FLESHCREEP

That's quite alright.

DAME

But surely you don't really expect my Jack to climb the beanstalk, do you?

FLESHCREEP

That's where he'll find the giant's castle as well as all the treasure.

JACK

Think about it, mum. we will never have to work...

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

KING PRODUCES HIS SWORD

I can take care of myself.

KING LOOKS UP AT THE BEANSTALK

PRINCESS

I told you that Jack was speaking the truth, but would you believe him?

KING

Please accept my sincere apologies. Even though I could see the beanstalk from more than a mile away, I couldn't believe my own eyes.

PRINCESS

I do hope Jack and his mother arrive home safely.

KING

Don't worry my dear, I'm sure they will be just fine.

PRINCESS CRIES

It breaks my heart to see you in such distress. I'm going to join them.

PRINCESS

You can't, Father!

KING

Please, my love, don't stare at me like that, there isn't any other option.

PRINCESS

Then I'm coming with you

KING

You most certainly will not, Giant Land is no place for a young lady. You will remain here, and I will be back soon, I promise.

FLESHCREEP ENTERS L AND THE AUDIENCE REACTS

FLESHCREEP (TO OFF)

You can play it now!

THE BADDIE ENTRANCE MUSIC PLAYS. FLESHCREEP MOVES DC.
PRINCESS AND KING ARE NOT PLEASED TO SEE HIM. THEY IGNORE HIM
AND TALK AMONG THEMSELVES

(TO THE AUDIENCE, QUIETLY)

I would hypnotise them into forgetting everything, but I'm in no doubt that you horrible lot will remind them, so what happens now in on you.

FLESHCREEP MOVES C AND WITH A HAND GESTURE HE PUTS PRINCESS AND KING INTO A TRANCE

(TO EVERYONE)

Look into my eyes, what can you see?

PRINCESS/KING

(TO FLESHCREEP)

Your contact lenses.

FLESHCREEP

You are feeling very sleepy.

PRINCES AND KING SCORE

(ANGRY)

Stop snoring.

PRINCESS AND KING STOP SNORING

And now for your orders.

KING

I'll have a Big Mac and large fries, but don't hold back on the gherkins.

PRINCESS

And can you please make me a banana milkshake with ice cream, but without those horrible paper straws.

FLESHCREEP

Quiet! Repeat everything, I say.

PRINCESS/KING

You told us to be quiet!

FLESHCREEP

I said "repeat everything I say"

PRINCESS/KING

I said "repeat everything I say"

FLESHCREEP

No, not yet, in a moment.

PRINCESS/KING

No, not yet, in a moment.

FLESHCREEP (TO AUDIENCE)

Stop laughing, it's not at all funny.

PRINCESS/KING

Stop laughing, it's not at all funny.

FLESHCREEP (TO HIMSELF)

I give up.

PRINCESS/KING

I give up.

FLESHCREEP (TO EVERYONE)

Quiet and follow me.

PRINCESS, KING AND FLESHCREEP EXITS L

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 2: INSIDE CAVERN

MAGIC LAMP IS UC. PRINCESS AND KING ENTER L. FLESHCREEP ENTERS CL AND THE AUDIENCE REACTS

FLESHCREEP (TO EVERYONE)

One! Two! Three!

PRINCESS AND KING AWAKEN FROM THE TRANCE AND ARE SCARED AND CONFUSED TO FIND THEMSELVES IN A CAVERN. THEY ALL MOVE CR

KING (TO FLESHCREEP)

I demand you release us at once!

FLESHCREEP

This is Blunderbore's secret hideout, but for now it's your new home. And the magic harp will soon be mine and nobody will be able to stop me.

FLESHCREEP GIVES AN EVIL LAUGH AND EXITS L. THE ENTRANCE TO THE CAVERN CLOSES

KING (TO PRINCESS)

We're trapped and there doesn't seem to be any way out.

PRINCESS (TO HERSELF, SHOUTING)

I'm a celebrity! Get me out of here!

KING NOTICES THE MAGIC LAMP, MOVES UC AND GRABS HOLD OF IT

KING (TO HIMSELF, THINKING)

I wonder.

PRINCESS (TO KING)

Father?

KING (TO AUDIENCE)

According to the legend, there is a magic lamp in a cavern full of treasure. Surely it can't be that simple. (THINKING)

If only I could remember how to summon the Genie.

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

What was that?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

PRINCESS (TO AUDIENCE)

Rub the lamp?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

KING

Are you sure?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

How many times?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND KING RUBS THE LAMP THREE TIMES. THE LAMP SHAKES IN HIS HAND AND FLIES OFF L. GENIE ENTERS L

GENIE (TO EVERYONE)

Not you again. I've already told you that you've exhausted all your wishes.

(REALISES)

I'm so sorry; I thought you were Aladdin.

(CONCERNED)

You're not Abananzar, are you?

KING (TO GENIE)

Abananzar? I've never heard of him. No, I'm the King and

(POINTING TO PRINCESS)

this beautiful young lady is my daughter, Princess Jill.

GENIE (TO PRINCESS)

It's a pleasure to meet you both, your Royal Highness.

PRINCESS (TO GENIE)

You too.

GENIE (TO EVERYONE)

I can't remember the last time I met royalty, must be more than a century ago.

KING

We're trapped inside and was hoping you could help us.

GENIE

How about I grant you three wishes that you can use to escape and take all of the treasure home with you?

PRINCESS

Take the treasure home with us? I wish I had thought of that.

GENIE CLAPS THEIR HANDS

GENIE (TO PRINCESS)

That's one wish. Two remaining.

KING

That's not fair.

PRINCESS (TO HERSELF)

I do wish I hadn't said that.

GENIE CLAPS THEIR HANDS. PRINCESS AND KING ARE NOT PLEASED

GENIE

That's your second wish. There is only one left, so, what is it going to be?

KING (TO GENIE)

We must locate the Trott family. Take us to where they are, right now!

GENIE

Is that your third wish?

PRINCESS

Yes.

PRINCESS AND KING HOLDS HANDS WITH EXCITEMENT AND GENIE CLAPS THEIR HANDS

FADE-TO-BLACK FOR A FEW MOMENTS

THE ENTRANCE TO THE CAVERN OPENS. FLESHCREEP ENTERS L, THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND HE IS ANGRY TO FIND PRINCESS AND KING NOWHERE TO BESEEN AND MOVES DC.

FLESHCREEP (TO AUDIENCE)

Were you behind their escape?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

Oh yes you were!

AUDIENCE REACTS

Oh yes you were!

AUDIENCE REACTS

I must overcome my fear of heights and stop them from derailing my evil plans.

FLESHCREEP GIVES AN EVIL LAUGH. AND THE AUDIENCE REACTS AS HE EXITS L

SCENE 3: FOREST

JACK AND DAME ENTER CL, SCARED. JACK IS CARRYING A SMALL BAG.

JACK (TO DAME)

I don't like this place, it gives me the heebie jeebies

DAME (TO JACK)

Me too. It must be the scariest place I've ever visited.

JACK

Really? Have you never been to The Blackpool Tower Dungeon?

DAME

Has it occurred to you that despite not wearing warm clothes we're not cold?

JACK

Cold? We should be freezing.

DAME

(REALISING)

Of course, Giant Land is believed to be magical place, my dear.

JACK

Either that or Blackpool Community Theatre doesn't have the budget.

DAME NOTICES THE AUDIENCE

DAME (TO AUDIENCE)

Oh, hello, what are you doing here?

DAME AND JACK MOVE DC

JACK (TO AUDIENCE)

It really is lovely to see you all again, but you really didn't have to join us.

DAME (TO JACK)

If they hadn't, they would have missed the remainder of the pantomime.

JACK (TO DAME)

That's true.

(TO AUDIENCE)

Are you enjoying the show?

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

DAME (TO AUDIENCE)

Good!

JACK (TO AUDIENCE)

Do you think this forest is haunted

THE AUDIENCE REACTS

DAME (TO JACK)

Don't worry, son, I've heard that singing may scare away evil ghosts.

JACK (TO DAME)

Your singing would scare anyone away.

DAME

Jack, I'm being serious.

PRINCESS AND KING ARE DELIGHTED TO SEE DAME AND JACK. THEY MOVE DC.

(TO KING)

Your Majesty

DAME BOWS TO KING AND PRINCESS

JACK (TO PRINCESS, SURPRISED)

Princess, what are you doing here? You must return to Dingly Dell.

KING (TO JACK, ANGRY)

My daughter doesn't take orders from you,

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

My father and I were held captive by Fleshcreep, and we managed to escape with the help of the Genie of the lamp.

JACK (TO PRINCESS, SURPRISED)

Genie? Lamp?

KING

And he intends to steal the magic harp. (TO DAME/JACK)

Fleshcreep is far more evil than we could have imagined.

JAC

Have you used up all of your wishes? I mean, you could finally put an end to he's evil ways while making us all extremely wealthy.

DAME (TO JACK)

That's irrelevant, son, remember that anybody who summons the Genie of the lamp is granted three wishes.

JACK IS EXCITED

KING (TO JACK/DAME)

I'm afraid we no longer have it.

PRINCESS (TO JACK/DAME)

It's in a cavern, and we have no idea of its location

JACK

The decision is then made, you must return to Dingly Dell.

KING (TO JACK)

I won't warn you again.

JACK (TO KING)

With all due respect, this is Giant Land; your royal status is not recognised here.

KING (TO PRINCESS)

And you wish to marry this boy?

JACK (TO PRINCESS/KING)

Look, you're both very brave, but it's far too dangerous, and we can't expect you to put your lives in jeopardy.

PRINCESS (TO JACK)

We aren't leaving without you.

DAME

No harm shall come to them, son, as long as they stay close to us, they'll be safe.

PRINCESS MOVES CLOSER TO JACK. KING PRODUCES A MOBILE FROM HIS POCKET, LOOKS AT THE SCREEN AND THEN TO R

KING (TO EVERYONE)

The giant's castle is less than three miles in (POINTING TO R)

that direction, according to Google Maps, we should arrive within the hour.

JACK (TO EVERYONE)

I'm too exhausted, I can't continue our journey, not without first having a rest.

EVERYONE SITS DOWN

DAME

Let's have a singsong.

(TO EVERYONE)

How about There are no ghosts or hauntings around here?

JACK (TO DAME)

I do love that song.

(TO AUDIENCE)

And do let us know if you see any ghosts.

PRINCESS AND KING LOOK AT EACH OTHER SCARED

SONG 6: THERE ARE NO GHOSTS AND HAUNTINGS AROUND HERE

EVERYONE

THERE ARE NO GHOSTS OR HAUNTINGS AROUND HERE
I SAID THERE ARE NO GHOSTS AND HAUNTINGS AROUND HERE

DAME SCREAMS AND SCARED, THE GHOST QUICKLY EXITS CL

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 4 GIANT'S CASTLE

TREASURE, HARP AND CHAIR ARE CL. HARP IS ASLEEP. GHOST AND PRINCESS ENTER CR GHOST IS HOLDING ONTO HER ARM, WHO HAS HER ARMS TIED AND MOVES CL. PRINCESS IS IN A TRANCE. GHOST SITS HER DOWN ON THE CHAIR. FLESHCREEP AND BUTTERCUP ENTER CL, AUDIENCE REACTS AND GHOST EXITS CL. FLESHCREEP AND BUTTERCUP MOVE C AND FLESHCREEP LOOKS AT HARP.

FLESHCREEP (TO HIMSELF)

The magic harp, finally, within my grasp.

FLESHCREEP GRABS HOLD OF HARP AND HE/SHE WAKES UP.

HARP (TO FLESHCREEP)

Hello, Master. Do you want me to sing something to you?
(REALISING)

You're not Master Blunderbore. Who are you?

FLESHCREEP (TO HARP)

Be quiet! You'll awaken him.

BLUNDERBORE (TO OFF)

Fee-fi-fo-fum!

FLESHCREEP LET'S GO OF HARP

I smell the blood of an Englishman. Be he alive or be he dead. I'll grind his bones to make my bread.

FLESHCREEP (TO OFF)

Master, it's just me. (TO PRINCESS)
One! Two! One!

PRINCESS AWAKENS FROM HER TRANCE AND IS SURPRISED TO FIND HERSELF IN THE CASTLE

BLUNDERBORE

What are you doing in my castle? You've never visited Giant Land before.

FLESHCREEP (TO OFF)

I've brought you a present.

FLESHCREEP POINTS TO BUTTERCUP

PRINCESS

No, Fleshcreep, you can't, not Jack's beloved Buttercup.

BLUNDERBORE

And who is this mysterious young lady?

FLESHCREEP

This is the King's daughter, Princess Jill.

BLUNDERBORE

I stole all of his treasure.

(LAUGHS)

What is she doing here? Is she my second course?

PRINCESS (TO OFF)

Second course? You can't eat me or Buttercup. You have more money than you could ever imagine. How about a Dominos delivery instead?

BLUNDERBORE

Silence her, or I'll have you for dessert.

FLESHCREEP MOVES CL

FLESHCREEP

Yes, Master.

FLESHCREEP PLACES A GAG ON PRINCESS

(TO AUDIENCE)

This is the best gag in the whole pantomime.

BLUNDERBORE

You don't always make me chuckle, but you do every now and then.

FLESHCREEP

Thank you, Master.

BLUNDERBORE

So, what brings her here?

FLESHCREEP

I was hoping she'd be your personal assistant, she can sing to you, make your bed, cook for you, and so much more.

BLUNDERBORE

Okay, you've done well.

FLESHCREEP

Yes, Master.

BLUNDERBORE I

I'm going to take a nap before I eat my dinner. When it's finished, wake me up and keep her quiet. I had better not be disturbed.

BLUNDERBORE FALLS ASLEEP AND SNORES

FLESHCREEP (TO AUDIENCE)

If Jack doesn't hand over the magic harp, he will lose his precious fiancée.

(EVIL LAUGH)

SONG 7: OBEY ME INSTEAD

(TO PRINCESS)

MY DEAR GIRL

YOU THINK YOU'RE PRETTY.

WHAT A SHAME IT HAS TO END

I HAVE PLANS AND YOU AREN'T IN THEM.

SAY GOODBYE MY YOUTHFUL FRIEND

(TO AUDIENCE)

I WILL KILL HER, SHE WILL DIE.

YOU'LL BE CALLING C.S.I

THE GIRL WILL SOON BE DEAD.

THE FAIREST OF THEM ALL

SHE WON'T BE THAT ANYMORE.

JACK WILL OBEY ME INSTEAD

(TO PRINCESS)

YOU HAVE DREAMS, I HAVE OBSESSION.

I WILL TAKE THE MAGIC HARP

YOU THINK HE'LL HAVE ITS POSSESSION. I WILL WIN, JACK'S NOT SO SHARP

(TO AUDIENCE)
I WILL KILL HER,
SHE WILL DIE.
YOU'LL BE CALLING C.S.I
THE GIRL WILL SOON BE DEAD,
THE FAIREST OF THEM ALL
SHE WON'T BE THAT ANYMORE.
JACK WILL OBEY ME INSTEAD
THE FAIREST OF THEM ALL.
SHE WON'T BE THAT ANYMORE
JACK WILL OBEY ME INSTEAD

FLESHCREEP AND BUTTERCUP EXITS L, THE AUDIENCE REACTS AND JACK ENTERS R CARRYING A SMALL BAG. PRINCESS IS DELIGHTED TO SEE HIM, BUT JACK DOESN'T NOTICE HER

JACK (TO AUDIENCE)

Well that took longer than expected and I've managed to unlock the cat flap door allowing me to make a quick exit.

JACK NOTICES PRINCESS

(TO PRINCESS)

Princess, why didn't you wait for me outside the castle?

REALISING HER HANDS ARE TIED AND MOUTH GAGGED, JACK MOVES L AND UNTIES PRINCESS

PRINCESS

Fleshcreep has Buttercup.

JACK

(SHOUTS)
Buttercup!

PRINCESS

Jack, be quiet, you'll awaken Blunderbore.

PRINCESS POINTS CL. JACK IS SURPRISED TO SEE BLUNDERBORE

JACK

Where is she?

PRINCESS

I'm not sure. I had no idea she was here until he mentioned having her for dinner.

TACK

Dinner? And why didn't Fleshcreep steal the harp? All he had to do...

JACK MOVES UC

...was pick it up and -

JACK GRABS HOLD OF THE HARP

HARP (TO JACK, LOUDLY)
Hello, Master.

SURPRISED, JACK LETS GO OF HARP

(REALISING)
Not again. Who are you?

PRINCESS MOVES C

JACK (TO HARP)

Please be very quiet.

(TO PRINCESS)

Of course. Fleshcreep will wait until I'm out of the castle before attempting to seize the harp. He's terrified of the giant just as much as we are. And it's no wonder Doctor Proctor promised to make me rich. The harp must be priceless.

KING, DAME AND BUTTERCUP ENTER CR..[JACK AND PRINCESS MOVE CR AND KING HUGS PRINCESS. JACK IS DELIGHTED TO SEE BUTTERCAKE, PRINCESS AND DAME

DAME (TO JACK)

She was with Fleshcreep in the kitchen. It'll only be a matter of time until he notices she's gone.

KING (TO PRINCESS)

Are you alright, my dear? He didn't hurt you, did he?

PRINCESS (TO KING)

No, I'm fine, but I never expected to see you again.

JACK (TO DAME/PRINCESS/KING)

We must leave here immediately!

KING (TO DAME)

Yes, Blunderbore could awaken at any time.

DAME NOTICES BLUNDERBORE

DAME

Giant!

BLUNDERBORE STOPS SNORING AND WAKES UP. DAME, JACK, PRINCESS AND KING BACK AWAY SCARED AND MOVE R

BLUNDERBORE

Who goes there?

PRINCESS (TO OFF)

No, wait! (THINKING)

They're here to - em -

JACK (TO OFF)

I've brought you some dinner.

PRINCESS

Excellent

(REALISING HERSELF)

I mean, yes, Jack has brought you a pizza. I made the arrangements with Fleshcreep. I told him I didn't want to return to Dingly Dell. So, he didn't need to keep me as a prisoner and now I'm your servant.

BLUNDERBORE

Really?

PRINCESS

Yes, honest. It's boring in the village, as there's hardly anything to do. And Fleshcreep should be back soon with your dessert

BLUNDERBORE

I want my dinner now. Give it to me!

JACK PRODUCES A PIZZA SLICE FROM HIS BAG

PRINCESS

Certainly.

JACK THROWS THE PIZZA OFF L. BLUNDERBORE IS EATING AND FALLS
ALSEEP AS JACK AND PRINCESS LOOK AT BLUNDERBORE WITH
EXCITMENT. FLESHCREEP ENTERS L DISGUSED AS DOCTOR PROCTOR AND
MOVES C

JACK (TO FLESHCREEP)

What are you doing here?

DAME (TO FLESHCREEP)

You told us you were scared of heights. What kind of game are you playing?

JACK

We risked our lives for you.

FLESHCREEP (TO AUDIENCE, QUIETLY)

So, my identity remains a mystery and soon my mission shall be complete (TO EVERYONE)

As soon as I realised how much danger you were in, I had to come to your rescue.

BLUNDERBORE (OFF)

Fee-fi-fo-fum!

FLESHCREEP (TO JACK)

Jack, give me the harp, she will send us back home.

JACK IS ABOUT TO HAND FLESHCREEP HARP WHEN BLUNDERBORE SHOUTS:

BLUNDERBORE

Fee-fi-fo-fum! What have you done?

PRINCESS

Run!

EVERYONE MAKES A QUICK EXIT L

FADE-TO-BLACK

SCENE 5: FOREST

DAME, JACK, PRINCESS, BUTTERCUP, HARP, KING AND FLESHCREEP DISGUISED AS DOCTOR PROCTOR ARE C

DAME (TO HARP)

I don't understand, why didn't you use your magic to escape from Blunderbore?

HARP (TO DAME)

That's impossible as my magic doesn't work...

JACK FALLS ASLEEP, AUDIENCE REACTS AND JACK WAKES UP

...in the giant's castle.

PRINCESS (TO FLESHCREEP)

HARP (TO FLESHCREEP)

No, it cannot be done.

FLESHCREEP

But if it weren't for me, you would still be in the giant's castle. I demand you do as you are told.

HARE

You don't have a kind heart. I'm not going to use my magic for evil.

JACK (TO HARP)

Harp, send Fleshcreep to Preston and for him to never ever return.

FLESHCREEP (TO JACK)

No, I've learned my lesson, please don't send me there.

JACK (TO FLESHCREEP)

Do you promise to not bother us ever again?

DAME (TO FLESHCREEP)

Or anyone else?

FLESHCREEP (TO EVERYONE)

Yes, from now on, I shall be good, I promise. Please forgive me.

JACK

Then if you are truly sorry you are forgiven.

(TO HARP)

Harp, if it's okay with you, you can come home with us.

HARP (TO JACK)

Yes, I'd like that and in return I will make all your wishes come true. Do you have any requests?

TACK

Well, I'm not sure, I haven't had any time to think about it.

PRINCESS (TO HARP)

I wish for all our friends in the audience to be given balloons at the end of the pantomime.

JACK

And finally, for us to all return home to Dingly Dell.

MAGICAL MUSIC IS HEARD
