RULES & REGULATIONS

TENNIS RULES

1. The rules of tennis of the U.S.T.A. and its Code of Conduct shall apply at all times, except when in conflict with the local rules or with any of the rules herein.
2. Proper tennis attire is required at all times.
3. Proper tennis etiquette should be observed at all times. Excessive noise, tennis racquet throwing or profanity will not be permitted on the courts or in the area of the courts, at any time.
4. Any activities other than tennis and basketball are NOT permitted.
5. Use of the tennis courts and facilities at the Club shall at all times be subject to the control of the Pool and Clubhouse Committee (PCC). Courts will be closed when necessary for maintenance, when dictated by safety considerations or adverse weather conditions or for any reason determined by the PCC.
6. Guest Policy for Tennis Courts – a member may have up to three guests in order to form a doubles match. If the second court is not being used by another member, it may be used for guest play until a member shows up to play at which time the court must be relinquished.
7. Lights must be turned off when leaving tennis courts. Failure to turn off the lights may result in a fine or termination of the membership.
8. Violating the rules can result in disciplinary action such as fines or termination of the membership, as determined by the Pool and Clubhouse Committee (PCC).

BASKETBALL COURT RULES

1. Use of the tennis courts take precedence over basketball use.
2. Proper shoes are required to play basketball.
3. Players must bring their own basketball.
4. Lights must be turned off when leaving the basketball courts. Failure to turn off the lights may result in a fine or termination of the membership.
5. Violating the rules can result in disciplinary action such as fines or termination of the membership, as determined by the Pool and Clubhouse Committee (PCC).
