Dear Phoenix East Aviation Team,

Once again, two of your aircraft—BPX262 and BPX209—flew low and directly over my residence in Ormond Lakes today, with no valid reason to do so. These flyovers occurred at altitudes and paths that do not align with any safe or necessary training protocol, and I am formally documenting these actions as part of an ongoing pattern of harassment.

I have both video evidence and flight path recordings from today's incidents. This behavior is disruptive, unnecessary, and violates the spirit—if not the letter—of FAA voluntary noise abatement procedures and basic community respect.

This is now a repeated issue despite prior complaints. The continued disregard for residential well-being is unacceptable and will be escalated legally if necessary.

I am asking—again—for your flight operations team to immediately cease routing flights over my neighborhood and ensure all pilots are made aware of this concern.

P.S doesn't matter if you reply or not, not replying is your guilt!!!

You tried to hide BPX262 as it, did not display who this plane belonged too but I found it. It was Phoenix East Aviation. You can see in the image no name.

The number “BPX262” is actually an airline-style callsign used by Phoenix East Aviation, not an FAA registration number (which always begins with “N”). So the operator—not a private individual—is Phoenix East Aviation, LLC, based at Daytona Beach International Airport (DAB)

These aircraft are owned and controlled by the flight school, not private individuals. If you're tracking low-altitude flights using FlightRadar24 or FlightAware, you're seeing their training flights—not personal or privately-owned planes.
