## Historical Background and Establishment of Colombia



## What to bring?

### 1. Documents & Money

**Passport:** Valid for 6+ months.

**Paperwork:** Digital/printed copies of flights, insurance, and entry forms.

**Money:** Credit cards (notify bank) + mixture of Local Currency and small USD bills.

### 2. Clothing (Keep it Simple)

**General:** Pack light, breathable fabrics (linen/cotton).

**The Checklist:** Daily casual wear, one warm layer (buses/hotels have freezing A/C), long pants (for mosquitos/churches), rain jacket, and swimwear.

### 3. Footwear

**Walking:** Broken-in sneakers with good support (essential for cobblestones).

**Leisure:** Flip-flops or sandals for showers and pools.

### 4. Health & Hygiene

**Protection:** High SPF sunscreen + Insect Repellent.

**Medications:** Bring any personal prescription medicines, along with basic remedies for pain, fever, and digestive discomfort.

**Hygiene:** Hand sanitizer + small tissue pack (public restrooms often lack TP).

### 5. Tech & Gear

**Electronics:** Universal power adapter (voltage and plug types vary across the region—check your device compatibility), power bank, and phone with offline maps.

**Safety:** Small luggage locks and a secure daypack.


**Water:** Never drink from the tap. Bring a bottle with a built-in filter or buy sealed water.
