





Afternoon: Descent to the town of Chivay to enjoy a local lunch. Later, visit the La Calera thermal baths.

Accommodation: Hotel selected in Chivay.



Day 7: Cruz del Cóndor – Puno

Morning: Breakfast at the hotel. Early departure to Cruz del Cóndor to witness the majestic flight of the condors over the canyon depth. We will also visit to the Tapay viewpoint where we can observe the depth of the canyon as well as the town of the same name. We will return visiting the villages of Pinchollo, Maca, Achoma, Yanque and the viewpoints of Antahuilque and Choquetico.

Afternoon: Visit local villages like Maca and Yanque. After a provided lunch in Chivay, depart on a 6-hour scenic drive to Puno.

Accommodation: Hotel selected in Puno.

Day 8: Lake Titicaca (Uros & Taquile)

Morning: Breakfast at the hotel. Boat excursion to the Floating Islands of the Uros (12,500 ft / 3,810 m.a.s.l.), built entirely of totora reeds. Next, sail to Taquile Island (12,959 ft / 3,950 m.a.s.l.) and a walk to the village (1h).

Afternoon: Free time to explore the local handicraft shops. Enjoy a traditional lunch prepared with regional products before returning to Puno.

Accommodation: Hotel selected in Puno.

Day 9: Route of the Sun (Puno – Cusco)

Morning: Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Cusco. Stops include Pucara (3,900 masl), and La Raya (4,335 masl), the highest point of the trip.

Afternoon: Enjoy a buffet lunch in Sicuani. Visit the Raqchi Archaeological Center (3,450 masl) known as the Wiracocha Temple of God and the Andahuaylillas Church (3,093 masl) built in 1,580 and known as “The Sistine Chapel of Peru”. Arrival in Cusco at 17:00.

Accommodation: Hotel selected in Cusco.

Day 10: Cusco City Tour

Morning: Breakfast at the hotel. Free morning to rest or explore the city at your own pace.

Afternoon: Guided tour of the Cathedral, Qoricancha (Temple of the Sun), and the ruins of Sacsayhuaman, Qenqo, Puca Pucara, and Tambomachay.

Accommodation: Hotel selected in Cusco.

Day 11: Sacred Valley of the Incas

Morning: Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to the Sacred Valley. Visit the ruins and the famous craft market of Pisac.

Train Conditions in Cusco

Non-Refundable: Train tickets are strictly non-refundable.

Station Arrival: Passengers must arrive at the station at least 30 minutes before departure.

Baggage Policy: Only one (1) piece of carry-on luggage is allowed, weighing no more than 8 kg (17.64 lb) and measuring no more than 55 cm x 35 cm x 25 cm.

Safety: Small luggage locks and a secure daypack.


