Tasting phases:

• Visual phase: Cherry red color, with purple iridescence, a sign of its youth and ruby reflections from its aging in the barrel.

- Nose: The primary aromas typical of the variety stand out. Blackberries and black fruits such as blueberries and gooseberries predominate. As time goes by and we allow the wine to breathe, we get delicate tertiary aromas, or aging, with slight vanilla and spicy tones such as black pepper.
- Palate: Powerful entry. It is a wine with a very good structure. Well balanced acidity
 and the alcohol is well integrated supporting the olfactory phase since we once again
 find a flavor with a lot of fruit, characteristic of the Tempranillo variety. We find a
 balanced wine which does not saturate the sense of smell or taste and invites you to
 continue drinking.
