1. What Are Cookies?

 - **Functionality Cookies:** These remember your preferences (e.g., language or region) and enhance your experience.
 - **Analytics Cookies:** We use third-party tools (e.g., Google Analytics) to understand how users interact with our site. These cookies may track usage patterns and device information.
 - **Marketing Cookies:** These may be used to deliver relevant content or measure the effectiveness of marketing campaigns. We do not use behavioural advertising cookies without your consent.
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3. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be set by third-party services integrated into our website, such as analytics providers or embedded content platforms. These providers may use cookies independently and are subject to their own privacy policies.

4. Managing Cookies

You can control and manage cookies through your browser settings. Most browsers allow you to block or delete cookies, and to set preferences for certain websites.

Please note that disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of our website.

5. Consent

When you visit our website for the first time, you will be presented with a cookie banner requesting your consent for non-essential cookies. You may update your preferences at any time.
