EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 2025 ANNUAL REPORT

Our Lady of Kibeho Orphanage Foundation

Our Lady of Kibeho Orphanage Foundation (OLOK Foundation) is a registered Canadian charity and Non-Government Organisation operating in Uganda. The Foundation is dedicated to providing food, shelter, healthcare, education, and life skills development to vulnerable orphaned girls. Most of the girls in OLOK's care have lost one or both parents, many due to HIV/AIDS and would otherwise face exploitation, abuse, and extreme poverty.

In 2025, OLOK continued to serve 99 orphaned girls, offering a safe, nurturing home environment where they can heal, grow, and pursue their education with dignity and hope.

Mission and Vision

OLOK's mission is to ensure that orphaned and disadvantaged girls receive essential care and access to quality formal education from primary through secondary levels, while fostering culturally appropriate life skills and spiritual formation within a loving home environment.

Our vision is to see every girl in our care equipped for an independent, healthy, and purpose-filled future, breaking cycles of poverty and vulnerability for generations to come.

2025 Highlights

Because of your generosity, 2025 was marked by stability, growth, and renewed hope:

- **Security & Protection:** Construction began on the government-mandated perimeter security wall, ensuring the safety of the girls in our care.
- **Education:** All girls remained enrolled in primary and secondary education, with strong academic progress and increased mentorship support.
- **Healthcare & Well-being:** The girls received consistent medical care, nutritious meals, and psychosocial support.
- **Life Skills Development:** Programs in personal development, vocational skills, and faith formation continued to prepare girls for independence and responsible adulthood.

1. Providing a Safe and Nurturing Home

Because of your faithful support, 99 girls experienced the security of a loving and structured home environment in 2025. Your generosity provided:

- Daily nutritious meals to support healthy growth and child development.
- Safe and secure housing
- Clothing and essential personal items
- Consistent access to medical care, including on-site nursing support
- Access to clean drinking water.
- Reliable power source which boosts security.

In a context where many of these girls would otherwise face exploitation, neglect, or extreme hardship, your support has created stability, dignity, and hope. Beyond meeting physical needs, you have helped create a home where each girl is known, protected, and valued.



These opportunities integrate literacy, numeracy, character formation, and life skills development, equipping the girls not only to succeed academically but to grow into confident, capable young women.

Education is the most powerful pathway out of poverty. Because of you, doors that once seemed closed are now wide open

2. Investing in Education

Education remains the cornerstone of long-term transformation. Through your contributions in 2025:

- School fees were partially paid for both primary and secondary students
- Scholastic materials and uniforms were supplied
- Academic mentorship and guidance were provided
- Girls attended trusted partner schools offering quality formal education

3. Strengthening Safety and Infrastructure

In 2025, significant progress was made towards meeting government safety requirements. A major milestone was the construction of a protective perimeter wall greatly enhancing security and safeguarding the girls and staff in our care.

This critical step moves us closer to full compliance while substantially improving the protection, stability, and wellbeing of everyone at Our Lady of Kibeho Orphanage Foundation.

4. Building Skills for the Future

Skill-Building and Sustainability Initiatives: In 2025, efforts to strengthen food security and practical skills continued to grow through the orphanage's farm. Here, the girls actively learn agricultural practices while contributing to food production, gaining hands-on experience that fosters responsibility, teamwork, and independence.

These programs not only support the daily needs of the orphanage but also equip the girls with valuable skills that promote self-suf-

ficiency and prepare them for a brighter, more empowered future.

The girls planted and were able to harvest Sweet potatoes, sweet cone, cassava, beans . All these have helped in boosting their nutrition.



5. Nurturing Faith and Spiritual Growth

At OLOK Foundation, the girls came to us with different faith backgrounds and it's our obligation to foster their beliefs. In 2025, the orphaned girls were supported in deepening their faith through prayer, participation in sacraments, and regular spiritual guidance. These opportunities helped the girls develop a sense of hope, purpose, and resilience, while strengthening their moral and ethical foundation.

Together, the girls gathered in prayer to lift up their own needs, the needs of the orphanage, and the intentions of the generous donors and supporters who requested prayerful remembrance. This shared spiritual practice fostered unity, gratitude, and a sense of belonging among the girls, creating a nurturing environment where they can grow in faith and character.

6. Health and Well-Being at OLOK

At OLOK Foundation, the health and well-being of the girls is a top priority. In 2025, thanks to the generosity of our donors, the orphanage maintained **a residence nurse** to attend to the medical needs of all the children, including those living with HIV/AIDS.

The nurse, fully supported through donor resources, ensures that every girl receives timely medical attention, regular check-ups, and compassionate care. Our sickbay provided essential medicines and supplies, allowing the nurse to respond immediately to illnesses and minor injuries.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all donors whose consistent support makes this possible. Your contributions ensure that the

girls at OLOK receive professional, round-the-clock healthcare, providing peace of mind to the children and their caretakers.

7. Financial Stewardship

At OLOK Foundation, we remain deeply committed to responsible financial management and transparency. Every dollar entrusted to us directly supports the care, education, and well-being of the girls.

Your continued engagement and generosity ensure that essential services remain uninterrupted, while also enabling long-term planning with confidence. Thanks to your support, we can maintain stability today and build a sustainable, thriving future for the girls in our care.

Our key priorities for 2026 include:


- **Completing critical safety infrastructure improvements** to ensure the continued protection of all girls and staff.
