Joe met his wife Gail while at San Diego State College and they were married in June 1964. After three years in the U S Navy followed by graduating from the University of California at Berkeley School of Law, Joe, Gail and their children Rick and Karen moved to Hawaii in 1971. Joe practiced law in Hawaii for 31 years until retiring as the General Counsel of Bank of Hawaii in 2002. Gail worked as a Domestic Violence

Prevention Specialist at the Kaneohe Marine Base until her retirement in 2000. Joe has kept busy in his retirement years by working as a flight instructor and as a volunteer tour guide on the USS Missouri Memorial. 
