They swim upright. Unlike most fish, sea horses swim in a vertical position using a small fin on their back.

Male sea horses give birth! The female lays eggs in the male's pouch, and the male carries them until they hatch

They have no stomach. Sea horses digest food so quickly that they need to eat almost constantly!

They can change color. To blend into their surroundings or communicate, sea horses can change their color.

Sea horses have curly tails.
Their tails help them anchor to seaweed and coral so they don't drift away

They are poor swimmers.
Despite living in the ocean, they are slow and often struggle in strong

currents

Their eyes move independently. Like chameleons, sea horses can look in two different directions at once

They eat tiny animals.
Sea horses feed on small creatures like plankton and baby shrimp

Sea horses are endangered. Due to habitat loss and overfishing, many sea horse species are at risk of extinction
