Grafting

When branches of two different trees touch each other, merge, and continue to grow, they have formed a natural graft. The two fused trees can share nutrients, minerals, and other necessities. Seeing this, early people learned to use grafting in agriculture as long ago as 500 BCE. Most woody plants can be grafted or budded, but the







tion of several. When a third plant is added between two others to become a trunk it is called an interstem. Budding is another method of grafting in which the scion is a single bud rather than a piece of stem or twig. Budding forms a stronger union, is faster and, often, more successful, than any other grafting technique. Because only a single bud

processes are labor intensive and require skill. The technique is used only used by orchardists, horticulturists, or pomelogists when it will provide a marked advantage over more convenient propagation techniques. Grafting is a form of cloning. A graft is performed when a scion is inserted into the lower portion of a tree. The scion becomes the top of the plant and the understock.

becomes the root system or part of the trunk. Although grafting usually refers to joining only two plants, it may be a combinais inserted, it is possible to produce several new plants even when scion wood of a new variety is scarce. Grafting is done in the spring using a sharp knife. Fresh, green cambium cells need to be exposed on both the scion and ruotstock for the graft to be successful. Both the routstock and the scion are cut in tongue and groove fashion so that they interlock. This allows the cambium cells to contact each other on at least two points. Ethyl Alcohol made from Apples

While no form of alcohol is good for us (isopropyl alcohol is used for sterilization and meetlyl alcohol is used for dissolving other substances), humans have a long history of ingesting ethyl alcohol as a recreational drug. Ethyl alcohol alters mood and behavior. Brewers and distillers usually make it from grains or other pieces of plant matter with high sugar contents. The human liver usually can filter ethyl alcohol from the body, but it is toxic when consumed fusier than the liver can metabolize it. Like methyl alcohol, ethyl alcohol can be used as an industrial solvent and as a fuel additive. Ethyl alcohol is naturally produced when

airhorne yeast cells fall into apple juice.
These microscopic fungi feed on the fruit sugars within the juace. With a ready supply of nutrients, the yeast population grows, and even more ethyl alcobol is produced. When all the sugar is consumed, the yeast become dormant, and the alcohol concentration in the now, "hard" cider is about 5 percent. Hard cider, apple wine, apple based beverages which contain ethyl alcobol. They differ in the methods used to arrive at their alcohol


Hard apple cider starts with freshly pressed, pasteurized apple juice or sweet cider. Yeast, and sometimes sugar, are added to the juice, and the container is scaled. As the container sits, the yeast sconsume the added sugar and/or the naturally occurring sugar in the apple juice and give off carbon dioxide as a part of their respiration process. Once the sugar is gone, the yeast can no longer make energy, so they go dormant. This fermentation process results in an elevated alcohol content of 3-5%. If the hard cider is re-fermented with more sugar, or infused with carbon dioxide, it will be effervescent (carbonated).







Diagram of banana palm




Bees and hummingbirds are attracted to the nectar of banana blossoms, but bananas do not require pollination to produce fruit.

> Wild species of bananas resemble cultivated bananas, except that they can reproduce through both seeds and suckers. Modern bananas have been bred to be sterile. Cultivated bananas contain black specks (the former seeds), which will not germinate.

In warm climates, banana plants are non-seasonal and fruit year-round. They need average temperatures of 80° F and yearly rainfall between 78 and 98 inches. They need rich, dark, fertile soils with steady moisture in the air and ground and good drainage.
