First-Time Voter

Who can register to vote?
f you are 17, you are old enough to vote! However, you must be 18 on Election Day in order to cast your
pallot. In addition to being at least 17, there are other requirements you must meet to register to vote:
☐ You must be a United States citizen.
You must be a resident of your state and county 30 days before the election.
☐ You are not serving a sentence of incarceration as the result of a criminal conviction.
What is the deadline for Voter Registration?
While you are able to register to vote at any time of the year, you must be registered to vote at least 21 day
pefore Election Day (OCTOBER 14, 2025) if you wish to vote in that election.
How can I register to vote?

OPTION 1: Register online through the New Jersey Voter Website: https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/register
n order to register online, you will need:
☐ A valid Driver's License or non-Driver ID card issued by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission
(MVC) OR a Social Security number
☐ The capability to sign on-screen or upload your signature to complete the registration process.

OPTION 2: Fill out the paper Voter Registration Application here: Voter Registration Application

***Whether your application is completed online or on paper, your signature is a very important part of your voter registration process. Your signature is kept on file to compare it to a vote-by-mail ballot or an electronic poll book if voting in person. Signature verification is how each voter's identity is confirmed to ensure the security and integrity of the ballot process.

Vote By Mail Application Deadline:

Must be received 7 days before Election Day (OCTOBER 28, 2025) or delivered in person by 3pm the day before Election Day (NOVEMBER 3, 2025).

Once you apply, you must vote by mail and will not be permitted to vote by machine in the same election.

Early Voting

OCTOBER 25 - NOVEMBER 2, 2025

In Monmouth County, there are 10 locations designated for Early Voting.

The Early Voting period is 9 days for the General Election.

Hours at designated polling locations during Early Voting are 10am - 8pm except Sunday, the hours are 10am-6pm.
